


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## Chapter 1 In the Beginning

The first chapter of Genesis tells the story of the creation of man made in the image of the creator. He is given dominion over the animal kingdom: “the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.” (Gen.1:28) that would pretty much be over all living things.

By Genesis chapter 3 we find that man has lost access to his home in the Garden (man refers to both the man and the woman) – driven out and locked out. Cherubims are placed at the east of the Garden along with a flaming sword which turns in every direction to deny any access to the tree of life. (Gen. 3:24)

God had given the man one simple commandment - not to eat from the tree of knowledge of good and evil. (Gen. 2:15) God said that “in the day” that man eats from the tree he (man) will certainly die. (Gen. 2:17) We know that Adam lived to be 930 years old and that Methuselah lived to be 969 years old. So we assume that Adam did not actually die on that day as we have been thought to interpret “in the day.”

2 Peter 3:8 sheds light on this. “But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.” We assume God was speaking about man’s day, a twenty-four hour day, but God was referring to His day. No man has ever lived out God’s day – one thousand years. Methuselah came within thirty years of God’s day.

Before being put out of the Garden of Eden, God told the serpent, “And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.” (Gen 3:15) The judgment for the serpent is that one will arise from the seed of man that will “bruise” also translated “break” his heel.

The word “heel” is figurative, “the rear of an army,” also meaning, “his military ranks,” and also it refers to the “hoof” as pertains to a horse’s hoof. It is interesting that when we read about the angelic host going to battle, there is always a mention of horses. I believe God is saying that the enemy that has risen up against him in the heavenlies and now in His Garden will be met in battle by the seed of the woman and his military ranks will be broken by her descendent.

Joel 2:1-11

[1] Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my holy mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble: for the day of the Lord cometh, for it is nigh at hand; [2] A day of darkness and of gloominess, a day of clouds and of thick darkness, as the morning spread upon the mountains: a great people and a strong; there hath not been ever the like, neither shall be any more after it, even to the years of many generations. [3] A fire devoureth before them; and behind them a flame burneth: the land is as the garden of Eden before them, and behind them a desolate wilderness; yea, and nothing shall escape them. [4] The appearance of them is as the appearance of horses; and as horsemen, so shall they run. [5] Like the noise of chariots on the tops of mountains shall they leap, like the noise of a flame of fire that devoureth the stubble, as a strong people set in battle array. [6] Before their face the people shall be much pained: all faces shall gather blackness. [7] They shall run like mighty men; they shall climb the wall like men of war; and they shall march every one on his ways, and they shall not break their ranks: [8] Neither shall one thrust another; they shall walk every one in his path: and when they fall upon the sword, they shall not be wounded. [9] They

shall run to and fro in the city; they shall run upon the wall, they shall climb up upon the houses; they shall enter in at the windows like a thief. [10] The earth shall quake before them; the heavens shall tremble: the sun and the moon shall be dark, and the stars shall withdraw their shining: [11] And the Lord shall utter his voice before his army: for his camp is very great: for he is strong that executeth his word: for the day of the Lord is great and very terrible; and who can abide it?

These are other references that mention horses in relation to angels. Perhaps we are prone to think that only things on the earth are specific to the earth. I feel as though we have been in a matrix all these thousands of years and we are about to wake up. We have been programmed to see while the eyes of our minds are wide closed. It is time to wake up and see the pictures that have been painted for us in the Bible. We have allowed history to become legend and legend to become myth.

Rev. 9:7

And the shapes of the locusts were like unto horses prepared unto battle; and on their heads were as it were crowns like gold, and their faces were as the faces of men.

Rev. 9:9

And they had breastplates, as it were breastplates of iron; and the sound of their wings was as the sound of chariots of many horses running to battle.

Rev. 9:17

And thus I saw the horses in the vision, and them that sat on them, having breastplates of fire, and of jacinth, and brimstone: and the heads of the horses were as the heads of lions; and out of their mouths issued fire and smoke and brimstone.

There is nothing mythical about the mentioned of these horses. Jesus will return to engage the enemy in the final battle where his heel will be bruised or as also translated, broken, for all eternity.

Rev. 19:11-14

[11] And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. [12] His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. [13] And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God. [14] And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

Therefore, we can neither overlook the mention of the serpent having seed, or offspring. It is the same word used for the woman's offspring. In other words, God is telling us what is to come. Not only will the woman conceive and produce offspring but the serpent will as well.

You will question the veracity of this statement but by the time we get to Genesis chapter 6 we see that the "sons of God" took wives of the daughters of men and they had children. Hence we have offspring of angelic beings mixed with the daughters of man. The mixing of the two races produced giants.

God knew what his arch enemy would be up to and so he spoke of the final outcome of the situation. Now the serpent knowing that one from the seed of man would come along and utterly destroy him, moved to taint the bloodline of the human race so

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that a pure descendant of man will not come forth and fulfill the prophecy spoken to him in the Garden of Eden. I am specifically speaking about the Messiah whose pure blood would cleanse the world of sin.

The serpent most likely believed that if the bloodline were tainted then the prophecy would be foiled. So, he set out to completely taint the bloodline of all humanity, but by the time of the flood, God had found a perfect man and his family to preserve the bloodline for the Messiah and humanity. Have you ever wondered why the Bible is filled with genealogy accounts? It is because God wants us to see that the plots of the enemy failed time and time again.

Throughout the Bible we see God leaving us a record of the pure bloodline up to the Messiah. We also see His record of the extent of the corruption of these “sons of God” who descended to the earth and mixed their DNA with that of the descendants of man. It doesn’t take a genius to understand that these angels damaged more than just the DNA of humanity before the flood.

If you study the use of the words “sons of God” you will find that it refers to angels. This topic will be dealt with in following chapters. Chapter 6 of Genesis gives clear indication to the extent of the corruption of God’s creation. It was not just the seed of man but also of all living creatures that were corrupted and their DNA altered. The tainting of the species were so extensive that God finally had to send the flood to utterly destroy all of creation with the exception of Noah, his family and two of every living creature, those that had not been tainted.

Genesis 6:12 depicts the extent of the defilement of creation, “And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth.” This included “both man, and beast, and creeping thing, and fowls of the air.” (Gen. 6:7)

I believe God made the earth and all its inhabitants within scale of man whom he would soon place in the Garden. His purpose was for man to have dominion over all living creatures and to tend the Garden. Wouldn’t it be far fetched that God would create creatures as large as the dinosaurs that would prevent man from being able to maintain dominion.

I believe God gave us a complete story of what has happened to the earth and why He had to finally destroy it. Not only did the angels who took these daughters of men and had children with them produce giants, but I believe they also defiled the animal kingdom and thus produced the animals we refer to as prehistoric.

Within eight generations from Adam to Noah, the earth and its inhabitants experienced a colossal change. Job speaks of great creatures that roam the earth during his days. He spoke of leviathan, behemoth and the unicorn. Yet we have not seen these creatures. Can it be that such creatures were tainted out of existence? Perhaps there was no viable DNA left to preserve some species.

I think it is quite interesting that the ark was built to house animals in scale with man. Certainly if greater space was needed God could have provided heavenly aid to build a much larger ark or extend Noah’s days so he could complete a larger ark. I think that would be preposterous in like of the various types of dinosaurs and sizes and to house two of each kind.

I note the way the verse reads in Genesis 6:20 concerning the creatures that should be brought onto the ark. “Of fowls after their kind, and of cattle after their kind, of every creeping thing of the earth after his kind, two of every sort shall come unto thee, to keep them alive.”

The key words are, “after their kind.” This is a reference back to Genesis 1:24, “And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind, cattle, and

creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind: and it was so.” The word “kind” should be translated as species. In other words, “species” pertains to that which maintains the integrity of DNA specific to its original DNA structure at creation.

This can be seen in Genesis 6:9 as Noah is referred to as “a just and perfect man in his generation.” The word in Hebrew is tamiym pronounced tau-meem’. According to the Strong’s Greek and Hebrew dictionary, “perfect” means, “entire (literal, figurative or moral); also (as noun) integrity, truth :- without blemish, complete, full, perfect, sincerely (-ity), sound, without spot, undefiled, upright (-ly), whole.”

How can this possibly be made simpler? God is stating here that Noah’s blood had not being tainted by angelic DNA. Morally he was a just man but physically he was perfectly human, without blemish. He was the perfect candidate to continue the race of man “after his kind.” This is the same for the animals that were saved. Two of each animal that was untainted were preserved in the ark with seven each of clean animals which some would be used to offer sacrifice holy and acceptable unto God after the flood and for food. The unclean (reference to dietary requirements) animals were brought on board the ark in pairs, male and female. (Gen. 7:2-3)

By Genesis chapter 7 we see all that would be preserved entering the ark and the rains ascending from the deep and descending. “The fountains also of the deep and the windows of heaven were stopped, and the rain from heaven was restrained.” (Gen. 8:2) The waters ceased coming up and falling down.

In chapter 8 of Genesis we are told about the voyage on the ark and the inhabitation awaiting a place of rest. By the time we get to chapter 9 we see how radically life on earth would change.

Now fear is introduced between man and beast. Genesis 9:2-3 makes this clear, “And the fear of you and the dread of you shall be upon every beast of the earth, and upon every fowl of the air, upon all that moveth upon the earth, and upon all the fishes of the sea; into your hand are they delivered. Every moving thing that liveth shall be meat for you; even as the green herb have I given you all things.” There is no longer trust between man and beast. Dominion is lost and trust is removed.

Each species must go its own way. The fear of man and the dread of man now became the decree to the animal kingdom. It was man’s original destiny to reign over the animal kingdom. God had placed such dominion in man’s hands. As everyone debarks from the ark we see a different level of cohabitation. The verse says, “...into our hands are they delivered.” (Gen. 9:2) Until this point, man and beast alike were commanded to eat the herbs of the earth as food.

Now we can see the extent of this deliverance – “Every moving thing that liveth shall be meat for you; even as the green herb have I given you all things.” (Gen. 9:3) The beasts of the earth become food for man.

You would think that this would be clear to Noah and his family what God meant as food, but suddenly we heard God clarifying the extend of eating flesh with this command. He said, “But flesh with the life thereof, which is the blood thereof, shall ye not eat.” (Gen. 9:4) The word used here for “flesh” is a euphemism to human flesh – that which pertains to man.

Why would God make such a distinction? Prior to the flood, things had become so corrupted that with giants on the earth and animals being manipulated in to colossal sizes, herbs and other produce were no longer in abundance and so the giants resorted to eating whatever was available. With a shortage of green herbs they probably resorted to cannibalism: giants eating humans for food, animals eating each other and so on. This was most likely one of the final straws that brought about the global flood.

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I do not believe the earth could have sustained human life including living creatures and tainted creation such as the likes of giants and mammoth size beast. The trees would have been depleted to build houses for giants most likely thirteen or more feet tall. This is using the size of the tallest giant recorded in the Bible, Og king of Bashan who is recorded as thirteen feet long and six feet wide. I would imagine that prior to the flood giants were much larger than Og. I believe after the flood God has placed restraints on the creation.

With the environment depleted of natural resources for food and shelter it is no far step to resort to carnivorous sustenance and finally cannibalism. Might it be even possible that animals were breed the size of dinosaurs for food and hard labor. Just imagine how the earth would have been changed with giants on the earth. The monoliths and pyramids would have been easy feats.

Also imagine the knowledge that the angels would have brought to humanity. Deut. 29:29 states, "The secret things belong unto the Lord our God: but those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children for ever, that we may do all the words of this law." The angels took the secret things of God and delivered them to man and thus man came into knowledge that defiled our spirit and nature.

I believe that prior to the flood it was the height of paganism and that the angels who mixed their seed with that of men made themselves to be as gods and caused man to worship them and their progenies instead of God. I believe as God said, all forms of evil abounded. There was genetic manipulation of humans, man and beast, all forms of sexual perversity, studies in divination as a means of interpreting God's prophecies in order to counter act them, exploitation of the natural resources of the earth to develop weapons, extracting herbal properties to use as mind altering drugs for mind control. Today's pharmaceutical companies are manufacturing psychotropic medication like it is Kool-Aid. Even children are being administered such drugs.

Food resources were being consumed at an alarming rate. How much food do you think a giant could consume in a day. With all living creatures being hybridized out of proportion to its original size, the earth could not possibly sustain life at a quality standard. I do not think it is possible for a person such as me to imagine the complete extent of the corruption of the earth during the days of Noah.

I know that we must come to grips with the extent of the demoralization of Noah's day because Jesus said that such will be in our time before the end comes. If you are thinking that Noah's days was just a time of marriage and partying you are sure to be wrong. The angels were taking daughters of men as wives and producing giant progenies. Knowledge abounded and it was perverted and unholy. Mind altering drugs were probably the elixir of the day. DNA manipulation was the science of the day and man had no use for God. Does this sound familiar?

Is it possible that such things had occurred? Genesis 6:5, 12 gives a good indication of this. "And God saw that wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually." "And God looked upon the earth, and behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth." If you can imagine it or if Hollywood has or have already depicted it, it probably happened.

Was this just something that happened before the flood? I do not believe so. I believe that Genesis 6:4 tells us that this did not all end with the flood. It states, "There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown." The sons of God made another visit after the flood and corrupted a segment of the population. It is clear that it was not a global

corruption this time. We know that it was extensive however because as we read the history of Israel's conquest of Canaan we see that they encountered cities upon cities of giants. This is why the Israelites were instructed to wipe all the inhabitants of Canaan because the bloodline was tainted.

The clearest proof recorded is the young shepherd boy's, David, encountered with Goliath. I believe that as a part of God's new covenant with Noah and the animals that survived the flood, He promises that "neither shall all flesh be cut off anymore." (Gen. 9:9-11) It is clear that angelic DNA and that of living flesh will not cleave as it once did.

Daniel 2:43 gives us hope that this mixing of DNA will not result in the same conclusion as in Noah's day. "And whereas thou sawest iron mixed with miry clay, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men: but they shall not cleave one to another, even as iron is not mixed with clay. Iron is to angel as clay is to man are metaphors used through out the Bible. This is also depicted in Rev. 9:9, 11, "And they had breastplates, as it were breastplates of iron; and the sound of their wings was as the sound of chariots of many horses running to battle...And they had a king over them, which is the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in the Hebrew tongue is Abaddon, but in the Greek tongue hath his name Apollyon."

There are verses upon verses in the Bible that gives evidence of giants living on the earth. This matter will be discussed at length in a later chapter.

Most references to giants are either stated as giants or the words "mighty men" are used instead. Isaiah 13:3 gives credence to the interpretation that these occurrences will happen once again. "I have commanded my sanctified ones, I have also called my mighty ones for mine anger, even them that rejoice in my highness." God declares that He has also called the mighty one, the same word used for giants, nephilims, those mixed with angelic DNA and human DNA to bring judgment.

Jesus also told us of they return when He said in Luke 17:26-27, "[26] And as it was in the days of Noe, so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man. [27] They did eat, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, and the flood came, and destroyed them all." So, if Jesus tells us to look at the days of Noah for the vision of what is to come, then we certainly need to understand all that occurred before the flood so we can be prepared to face and recognize when evil is upon us. The writing is on the wall and why are we not reading it.

I think it is because we read the Bible with preconceived interpretations and so when we read it we plug in what we think it says. Whether we want to admit it or not, most people, believers included, think the Bible is full of myths and nonessential recordings. I think this is why Isaiah 13: 7-8 states, "[6] Howl ye; for the day of the Lord is at hand; it shall come as a destruction from the Almighty. [7] Therefore shall all hands be faint, and every man's heart shall melt: [8] And they shall be afraid: pangs and sorrows shall take hold of them; they shall be in pain as a woman that travaileth: they shall be amazed one at another; their faces shall be as flames. (Emphasis mine)

This is a description of the proverbial expression, "shocked to death." And we will be! Imagine a teenager having a heart attack or a stroke from what he/she will see come upon the earth. I do not believe there is anyone on the earth that has that great an imagination. Steven King will even be at a lost to pen the horror of the day and those to follow.

It will come upon us with suddenness and it will over take us in our minds. The world is reaching its climax. We are poised to see things and not recognize what we see. Today it is quite normal in many countries to see people of all ages covered from

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head to toe in tattoos that depict ancient tribal drawings, ritual scarifications marks, and body piercings of pagan temple worship from eons ago. We think nothing of it.

I spent some time in Israel this year and found that even the nominal Israeli do not believe in God. Most Israelis culminate their military duty by traveling to the Far East, Thailand, India and such places for years at a time. They soak up not just the culture but the religious mumbo-jumbo as well. I met more atheist in Israel than I met believers in God. They trust more in their intellect and accomplishments than they do in their God. Most would tell you that they only believe in what they can see or touch. And as far as “chosen” goes, “this is the life” and that is all they will acknowledge. As for faith, they will outright tell you, “you believe what you want and I will believe what I want,” or “to each his own.”

When you stand at the altar in a church and see women and men with their pants hanging below their butts you know there is no longer a moral standard. It is no wonder that the prison culture has exploded onto the fashion scene when more than 8.75 million people are incarcerated globally. The prison code has become our dress code.

People holler about unethical scientific experimentations but in truth it doesn't matter while each nation has hidden compounds that experiment anyway. When they make a break through we hear about it. Dolly the cloned sheep died yet we have pet owners having their favorite pets cloned, the experiments continue. 1.5 billion babies have been aborted since World War II globally and the figure continues at a rate of 50,000,000 annually.

What is this all about? If a species can't reproduce then cloning is the answer. We know from the Bible that angels cannot reproduce. They are not given in marriage perhaps as the bible indicates they are all males and being the sons of God, created by him to specifically serve him. Man on the other hand was created to procreate –“to be fruitful and multiply” and to be in relationship, fellowship with God.

Daniel 4:43 clearly states, “And whereas thou sawest iron mixed with miry clay, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men: but they shall not cleave one to another, even as iron is not mixed with clay.’ In other words, the word is saying that the seed of the angels (iron) and the seed of man (clay) will not always take. Is it far fetched to believe that accounts of abductions by aliens are experiments in hybridizing two species?

Why so many experimentations? Is it because the seed of man and angels are no longer compatible so these angels are now focusing on cloning? Is Jurassic park really so far fetched? Why is there a hunt for fossils? Why are remains of giants whisked out of public view and knowledge? The world is full of secrets while our governmental agencies are fabricating rumors of extraterrestrials. Our eyes have been turned onto star gazing but in truth we ought to be looking for appearances of things that are supernatural manifesting in the natural – the invisible and the visible world. The spiritual realm is only another dimension of this world - the invisible world that coexists with this world.

National Geographic's documentaries prove to us that the old ways have never left us. People still continue the old traditions even if they have no idea why. Nothing has really changed. We have been building on what we already have and so we think all is well. We make changes here and there but it is still as in the days of Noah. Now we are using plastic and microchips, so what! It doesn't compare to the knowledge of the ancients. We can't figure out the past but we are trying to improve the future. We are ignorant in thinking our knowledge is superior.

Solomon was right when he said there is nothing new. Nothing new is exactly that. We are being manipulated by supernatural beings who control our societies from

high places and positions. This is not about a spaceship landing on planet earth; this is about the supernatural stepping unseen into our realm quicker than you can blink your eye. Is this possible? Jesus did this very thing on many occasions. Eye witnesses testified that He just appeared.

We don't believe that such things are possible. We don't believe that the age of the supernatural can really be ushered in. We think only horizontally as we relate to the real world. We don't want to see that we are heading in the same direction to the same outcomes as the ancients.

Yet Jesus said that it will be the same as in Noah's day. The earth was depleted of all its resources of food until man and nephilims were literally starving and breeding merely for food. Animals were bred larger most likely for labor and for food. When that became insufficient, I believe cannibalism was resorted to. How different will this be for our end time? Not much I speculate.

When the nephilims appear, I believe the earth will not be able to support them and us. I believe we are in the process of destroying our food source due to genetic manipulation. We are developing hybrids that are destroying old varieties and soon we will find that new strains of diseases will utterly destroy those new hybrids. These might not be susceptible to old diseases but they will be to the new ones that will be sure to eradicate them. Are things so different today than in Noah's day? Our resources are already running on empty. Then what will we eat – "Soylent Green?"

There is one marked occurrence that most people do not note when reading Genesis Chapters 5 and 6. By the end of Chapter 5 we see that all the righteous patriarchs had died. Isn't that interesting that God had removed all the righteous from the earth prior to the flood. Yet he spared Noah and his family as a remnant to preserve humanity. There is always a remnant and a ram in the thicket. For some reason, most believers are under the impression that we will all be out of here when the tribulation comes, but I believe we are in for an awful fright and a rude awakening.

What I find is that as long as I speak about spiritual things people will listen but the moment I speak on these things, they will close up or call me crazy. I say so what! I am right with God, what do I care what people call me. Hell is a bullet and it is in the chamber, the barrel is loaded, the trigger is cocked. God is getting ready to slam on that trigger and you had better wake up. They (the nephilims, those mixed with iron and clay) are coming and coming with the full fury of hell. The world including the believers is in for the long haul and we are not prepared for any of it. This is about more than just our own personal salvation. This is about the battle for the kingdom of men – all of humanity and not just us four and no more.

## Chapter 2 In His likeness And Image

In order to understand that there is a difference between the seed of man and the seed of the serpent we must understand that man was and is created in the likeness and image of God. Consider these verses.

Genesis 1:26-27

And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. [27] So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

Genesis 5:3

And Adam lived an hundred and thirty years, and begat a son in his own likeness, after his image; and called his name Seth:

Genesis 9:6

Whoso sheddeth man's blood, by man shall his blood be shed: for in the image of God made he man.

In Genesis 1:26-27, God defines the form that man would take upon creation. The same word used here for man is the same word used for man in Genesis 9:6. In Genesis 5:3 it is also the same word but it is a name of the first man created, Adam – capital “A”. ‘adam is the Hebraic word for man – lowercase “a.”

There is no difference between the man God created in Genesis 1 and the offspring of man that proceeds from Adam and Eve. In other words, God did not create Adam in his likeness and image in Genesis 1 and then caused the seed of man to be procreated in a different image – an likeness and image of man minus the likeness and image of God. The following verses simply cannot and should not be separated.

Genesis 5:1-3

[1] This is the book of the generations of Adam. In the day that God created man, in the likeness of God made he him; [2] Male and female created he them; and blessed them, and called their name Adam, in the day when they were created.

[3] And Adam lived an hundred and thirty years, and begat a son in his own likeness, after his image; and called his name Seth:

Verse one begins with god creating “ ‘adam,” “man” in His likeness and verse 2 defines the genders of that creation – male and female. Verse 3 shows the progression of that original creation, species, kind. It is clearly stating here that the seed – pure seed of man, produced offspring in that same likeness and image of God, that which man, ‘adam, was originally created in.

By Genesis 9:6 God is reaffirming that man is made in His image and continues to be reproduced in His image. He says that man should not shed the blood of man because man, ‘adam, is made in His image. Man is still capable of producing after his own kind – in the likeness and the image of God.

Remember, God had commanded that every living thing should reproduce after its own kind. Genesis 1:24 is very specific, "And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind: and it was so." We saw that by Genesis chapter 6 the sons of God descended and began to taint the pure blood line of man, 'adam.

It is important to see that the first verses in Genesis 5 is showing us that either the tainting of the human race had not yet begun or that it had but the direct offspring of Adam from the line of Seth had escaped the tainting. Remember, genealogy in the Bible is not just some frivolous pastime of the authors of the books of the Bible. Keeping track of the pure blood line of the human race was and is paramount to understanding end time prophecy.

This is why we are told as believers not to be unequally yoked. This is also why the Israelites were commanded to kill all inhabitants of the Promised Land before possessing the land. God intended for them to utterly wipe out the tainted race. Remember the first report from the twelve spies that encountered giants in the land and gave a bad report? Again, after the flood as it was before the flood, Genesis 6:4, "There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown."

Yet, the children of Israel failed to carry out the commandment of God and so they never acquired all the land that God had allotted to them. Also, those that remained in the land tormented Israel most of the years they possessed the land. By the time David was a young boy we find him encountering Goliath.

Goliath was not an anomaly in David's time nor was giants an anomaly even in Abraham's time. The following verses reveals who was in the land and why they were to be destroyed.

#### Genesis 15:12-21

[12] And when the sun was going down, a deep sleep fell upon Abram; and, lo, an horror of great darkness fell upon him. [13] And he said unto Abram, Know of a surety that thy seed shall be a stranger in a land that is not theirs, and shall serve them; and they shall afflict them four hundred years; [14] And also that nation, whom they shall serve, will I judge: and afterward shall they come out with great substance. [15] And thou shalt go to thy fathers in peace; thou shalt be buried in a good old age. [16] But in the fourth generation they shall come hither again: for the iniquity of the Amorites is not yet full. [17] And it came to pass, that, when the sun went down, and it was dark, behold a smoking furnace, and a burning lamp that passed between those pieces. [18] In the same day the Lord made a covenant with Abram, saying, Unto thy seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates: [19] The Kenites, and the Kenizzites, and the Kadmonites, [20] And the Hittites, and the Perizzites, and the Rephaims, [21] And the Amorites, and the Canaanites, and the Girgashites, and the Jebusites.

Abraham had a dream and in this dream "a horror of great darkness fell upon him." Could this horror be the second invasion of the sons of God and the tainting of the bloodline? I think it was. God is telling Abraham here that through his seed – an untainted bloodline will be preserved for the purpose of redeeming humanity from sin. But the catch was that God is merciful and at that point in time His mercy would not permit Him to punish the Amorites, because the extent of their sin did not justify utter destruction. Hence, "the iniquity of the Amorites is not yet full."

## Battle For The Kingdom Of Men

I believe the Amorite nation was possibly one of the first nations to be tainted after the flood including the other nations mentioned in verses 19 through 21. The defilement had not reached epic proportions as in the time of Noah. Remember, from the time of Seth to the time of Noah was approximately eight generation before judgment came. Now God is being specific here about the time frame before judgment comes, He said four generations from Abraham to Israel taking possession of the land and utterly wiping out the tainted inhabitants of the land.

I do not believe that this mean that everyone in the land was tainted, but I believe that many pure blooded humans allowed their daughters to marry the sons of God which once again gave rise to giants. I also believe others co-habited with them and so began to worship them as gods and learned false religions from them.

Nonetheless, humanity is still producing offspring after its own kind – the pure ‘adam race, untainted. Man was one created one way at creation and then because of the fall we became a different species. “After its own kind,” means exactly that. Yes, Adam and Eve were in a sinful state of mind. They had broken relationship with God and had chosen a different path form the original one He intended for humanity. We have the propensity to sin. It is our choice if we act on sin or not. It is not impossible to live a godly life but it is difficult.

Is such a thing possible? Yes it is. The Bible tells us that Enoch walked with God. We know that there were righteous men and women recorded in the Bible. Even though man made bad choices God was faithful to forgive them and continue to work through them. As long as man lived by the law and keep God’s commandments he was assured a life of hope in eternity. Yet the law could not save us because it condemned us. So God before the foundations of the world planned for the redemption of humanity through the shed blood of His son incarnate. This is why enemy tried so hard to utterly taint the bloodline of man so that the redeemer would not have access to the race of humanity.

God demonstrated for us in His word how he preserved a remnant of humanity to bring salvation to the world. Is all this so far fetched? If Adam produced offspring that was not in the likeness and image of God it would be impossible for the Messiah to come. Think about it, he could not be incarnate in flesh that was not after the likeness and image of God for He was God and what does light have to do with darkness. In other words, light cannot occupy darkness.

We are indeed born again because something must be dead in order to be born again. It must be in a state of death in order to be resurrected. Adam and Eve’s spirit that was in fellowship with God before the fall broke its connection with the divine. A bridge was necessary to reconnect the spirit of man to God – Jesus is that bridge. God told Adam that in the day he eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil he will surely die and that is exactly what happened. Adam never outlived God’s day. 2 Peter 3:8 states. “But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.” No man has ever outlived God’s day. Adam died at the age of nine hundred and thirty and Methuselah did at the age of nine hundred and sixty-nine, he was the oldest man who lived.

There is no need for us to spiritualize this situation because Adam did die “in the day.” This is like saying someone died “in the year.” The date is not given but it is presumed that in a specific year someone died. So it is the same here. God’s day is one thousand years and so “in the day,” Adam died. Specifically, Adam died nine hundred and thirty day during the given time frame of God’s day.

It is enough then that we acknowledge that we are made in the likeness and image of God. Humanity that remains untainted with angelic DNA is considered to be in the original state of Adam when he was created. However, it is also true to say that

without receiving the grace of God, the shed blood of Christ for the mission of our sins, man without this gift is separated from God.

As we begin to understand who we are, then it is possible to understand who our enemy is, why, and what is to come.

## Chapter 3 The Great Image

We have spent our lives believing the traditions of man's interpretation of God's word that when we read the word for ourselves we do not read God's word we read with interpretation already in play. So, we lack knowledge because our notions are the driving force behind our understanding. Interpretations must be revealed not passed on as a notion or traditional way of thinking. Old notions are often done away with because prophecy is something that is not really clear until the time approaches. We do see in a glass darkly and prophetic imagery does not appear as they ought until the time of fulfillment.

The Imagery in the Book of Revelation befuddles us because those things that are common to John are not common to us and those things that are to come were not common to John but are to us at this present time.

We must be able to sift through those things that were familiar to the person relating the prophetic and see them in the time of relevance. We should also consider the fact that the bearer of the prophetic is not always given the interpretation of the vision or dream and so therefore they speak in a glass darkly and prophecy in part.

Prophecy must be grouped together for a clear understanding. For example, the prophecy of Jesus is found through out the entire Old Testament and all must be read and studied for a clear understanding of the Messiah. Further, trying to understand prophecy by studying one text will not give a clear understanding. Also, if you go back to the first occurrence of the mention of a word or phrase it helps in comprehending prophecy.

Prophecy is like a road that one travels on; at each juncture more is revealed. If we miss a turn or a sign we can lose our way. If we try to interpret prophecy on our preconceived notions we miss the mark. To understand God's word we must come at it with a fresh mind and clear thoughts.

We must remember that the prophetic comes from God and so must the interpretation. Anything short of God giving the interpretation is divination and sorcery. History shows us that when individuals in the Bible had dreams and visions they would often call upon magicians, astrologers and sorcerers to give them the interpretation of the dreams. We have several stories in the Bible that tells us about kings that had dreams and no one in they pool of wise men were able to convey to them the interpretations. Yet among them were often found Hebrews that God revealed dreams and visions to. Joseph was one of those men.

In Genesis 40:8b Joseph declares to the Pharaoh's cup bearer and baker, "Do not interpretations belong to God?" And in Genesis 41:15-16 "And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, I have dreamed a dream, and there is none that can interpret it: and I have heard say of thee, that thou canst understand a dream to interpret it. And Joseph answered Pharaoh, saying, It is not in me: God shall give Pharaoh an answer of peace." "It is not me," notes Joseph, it is God. Joseph was wise enough to know that only the giver of the dream or vision is capable of interpreting His meaning.

This same scenario was repeated again in the Book of Daniel when Nebuchadnezzar had his vision of a great image. Daniel 2:27-30 states, "Daniel answered in the presence of the king, and said, The secret which the king hath demanded cannot the wise men, the astrologers, the magicians, the soothsayers, shew unto the king; But there is a God in heaven that revealeth secrets, and maketh known to the king Nebuchadnezzar what shall be in the latter days. Thy dream, and the visions of

thy head upon thy bed, are these; As for thee, O king, thy thoughts came into thy mind upon thy bed, what should come to pass hereafter: and he that revealeth secrets maketh known to thee what shall come to pass. But as for me, this secret is not revealed to me for any wisdom that I have more than any living, but for their sakes that shall make known the interpretation to the king, and that thou mightest know the thoughts of thy heart." Daniel also knew that God was the only one capable of revealing secrets and giving the interpretations thereof.

Everyone else can only guess or surmise what the Producer of the dream meant. Some in times pass and still today try to use the stars and even tea leaves to give interpretations of God's secrets. But none of that is necessary as God can still reveal and does, and His word has been established and we only need to do as Timothy told us to do, study to show ourselves approved unto God.

As we study God makes His word clear. Sometime we can read a passage and not remember having read the passage until all of a sudden it leaps out at us and finally revelation comes. This happens when we have learned to put aside our preconceived notions and when the fullness of time comes it makes sense. If it is not the appointed time for us to comprehend, then we can try to surmise the meaning but all we are doing is spinning our wheels. We come up with suppositions and conclusions that becomes our traditional way of thinking. We try to figure God out by walking in the natural. We try to apply reason without revelation to come up with interpretation. Too often we assume things that are not because we do not think that what God means is plausible or possible. Most often we do not follow the trail that has been laid out for us in the Bible. Things become much clearer as we get on the right trail.

I have been studying for some time now on the subject of the sons of God and their descendants, the giants of renown in Genesis 6:1-7, I found it strange at first that the Bible stated that the giants who were descendants of the sons of God (angels, watchers) and the daughters of men were all destroyed in the flood. Yet as I read through the Bible I found that even after the flood the giants, these descendants of angels and the daughters of man appeared on the earth again in astounding numbers. There were cities built by giants through out the Old Testament.

### GIANTS

Nephilim (those who descend)

**n<sup>e</sup>phiyl, Hebrew 5303, Strong's**

**n<sup>e</sup>phiyl**, *nef-eel'*; or **n<sup>e</sup>phil**, *nef-eel'*; from Hebrew 5307 (*naphal*); properly, a *feller*, i.e. a *bully* or *tyrant* :- giant.

**rapha', Hebrew 7497, Strong's**

**rapha'**, *raw-faw'*; or **raphah**, *raw-faw'*; from Hebrew 7495 (*rapha'*) in the sense of *invigorating*; a *giant* :- giant, *Rapha*, *Rephaim* (-s). See also Hebrew 1051 (*Beyth Rapha'*).

Genesis 6:4

There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown.

Numbers 13:33

And there we saw the giants, the sons of Anak, which come of the giants: and we were in our own sight as grasshoppers, and so we were in their sight.

Deut. 1:28

Whither shall we go up? our brethren have discouraged our heart, saying, The people is greater and taller than we; the cities are great and walled up to heaven; and moreover we have seen the sons of the Anakims there.

Deut. 2:10-11

The Emims dwelt therein in times past, a people great, and many, and tall, as the Anakims; [11] Which also were accounted giants, as the Anakims; but the Moabites call them Emims.

Deut. 2:20

(That also was accounted a land of giants: giants dwelt therein in old time; and the Ammonites call them Zamzummims;

Deut. 3:1

Then we turned, and went up the way to Bashan: and Og the king of Bashan came out against us, he and all his people, to battle at Edrei.

Deut. 3:11

For only Og king of Bashan remained of the remnant of giants; behold, his bedstead was a bedstead of iron; is it not in Rabbath of the children of Ammon? nine cubits was the length thereof, and four cubits the breadth of it, after the cubit of a man.

Deut. 3:13

And the rest of Gilead, and all Bashan, being the kingdom of Og, gave I unto the half tribe of Manasseh; all the region of Argob, with all Bashan, which was called the land of giants.

Joshua 12:4

And the coast of Og king of Bashan, which was of the remnant of the giants, that dwelt at Ashtaroth and at Edrei,

Deut. 9:1-2

Hear, O Israel: Thou art to pass over Jordan this day, to go in to possess nations greater and mightier than thyself, cities great and fenced up to heaven, A people great and tall, the children of the Anakims, whom thou knowest, and of whom thou hast heard say, Who can stand before the children of Anak!

Joshua 13:12

All the kingdom of Og in Bashan, which reigned in Ashtaroth and in Edrei, who remained of the remnant of the giants: for these did Moses smite, and cast them out.

Joshua 15:8

And the border went up by the valley of the son of Hinnom unto the south side of the Jebusite; the same is Jerusalem: and the border went up to the top of the mountain that lieth before the valley of Hinnom westward, which is at the end of the valley of the giants northward:

Joshua 17:15

And Joshua answered them, If thou be a great people, then get thee up to the wood country, and cut down for thyself there in the land of the Perizzites and of the giants, if mount Ephraim be too narrow for thee.

Joshua 18:16

And the border came down to the end of the mountain that lieth before the valley of the son of Hinnom, and which is in the valley of the giants on the north, and descended to the valley of Hinnom, to the side of Jebusi on the south, and descended to En-rogel,

1 Samuel 17:4

And there went out a champion out of the camp of the Philistines, named Goliath, of Gath, whose height was six cubits and a span.

2 Samuel 21:19

And there was again a battle in Gob with the Philistines, where Elhanan the son of Jaare-oregim, a Bethlehemite, slew the brother of Goliath the Gittite, the staff of whose spear was like a weaver's beam.

1 Chronicles 20:5

And there was war again with the Philistines; and Elhanan the son of Jair slew Lahmi the brother of Goliath the Gittite, whose spear staff was like a weaver's beam.

The question is asked whether or not sons of God refers to the angels? We need only look at the reference to the term sons of God as noted in the Bible to see that in the Old Testament it always referred to angel although we see the term in the New testament referring to the believers in Christ Jesus.

Genesis 6:2

That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose.

Genesis 6:4

There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown.

Job 1:6

Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the Lord, and Satan came also among them.

Job 2:1

Again there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the Lord, and Satan came also among them to present himself before the Lord.

Job 38:7

When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy?

## Battle For The Kingdom Of Men

John 1:12 states, "But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name." The reference "sons of God" refers to those that believe on Jesus' name as well. This is true because we sit in heavenly places with Christ "in whom we have boldness and access with confidence by faith of him" Ephesians 3:12. Being in Christ puts us in heavenly places along with the angels. Romans 8:14 continues this thought, "For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God." The angels that did not leave their habitation to go with Satan and his followers are referred to as sons of God. This is clear in Job 2:1 noted above when we see a distinction between the angels who came to present themselves before God "and Satan came also." Satan is clearly no longer a son of God. He is the renegade angel that sought to usurp God's throne.

Angels are also referred to in the Bible as stars. Take a closer look at each of these verses.

### STARS

#### Job 38:7

When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy? (The angelic choir and the sons of God, angels)

#### Daniel 8:10

And it waxed great, even to the host of heaven; and it cast down some of the host and of the stars to the ground, and stamped upon them. (Reference to the angelic host)

#### Matthew 24:29

Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken: (Finally the fallen angels shall be shaken out of heaven once and for all. Luke 10:18 "And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven")

#### Mark 13:25

And the stars of heaven shall fall, and the powers that are in heaven shall be shaken. (In Job we see that Satan still presented himself in heaven with the sons of God Job 1:6)

#### Jude 13

Raging waves of the sea, foaming out their own shame; wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever. (Wandering stars – the fallen)

#### Rev. 1:16

And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.

#### Rev. 1:20-2:1

The mystery of the seven stars which thou sawest in my right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: and the seven candlesticks which thou sawest are the seven churches.

#### Rev. 2:1

Unto the angel of the church of Ephesus write; These things saith he that holdeth the seven stars in his right hand, who walketh in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks;

Rev. 3:1

And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; These things saith he that hath the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars; I know thy works, that thou hast a name that thou livest, and art dead.

Rev. 6:13

And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind. (The fallen are finally shaken out of the heavens to do harm no more)

Rev. 9:1

And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit. (This star is personified)

Rev. 12:4

And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth: and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born. (A third part of the angels which fell)

We cannot negate scriptural mention of angels as “stars.” Knowing this and reading these verses once again in the right context will begin to give prophecy the right interpretation. We have missed to many signs because we simply can’t bring ourselves to accept the obvious because the outcomes if this is true is too much to imagine.

We also see throughout the Old Testament that people often made for themselves idols of various forms made from different materials. When the children of Israel first came to the foot of Mount Sinai they caused Aaron to make a golden idol in the form of a calf. In Exodus 20:23 they are told “Ye shall not make with me gods of silver, neither shall ye make unto you gods of gold.” Gold is the most precious of metals and silver is inferior to gold; this is followed by brass, then by iron, by clay and wood, each less inferior to the other.

As man progressed through history, our so called gods became less inferior to the ones they started out with. Satan is constantly trying to counterfeit God’s kingdom. He caused man to form gods in all the elements that are found in God’s temple. The objects in the tabernacle that Moses was given instruction to construct were made of Gold, silver, brass, iron and wood. These are exactly what Satan is using to make false idols of!

We have established that interpretation comes from God and that God reveals to us as we diligently study and at the appointed time. We have also established that they were giants in the earth before the flood and after the flood. There are no verses in the bible that clearly shows the race of giants was utterly destroyed. And we note that the term “sons of God” in the Old Testament always referred to angels not man. In the New Testament we note that the term ‘sons of God “as it refers to believers we are given power to becomes the sons of God. At no time prior to grace is man referred to as the sons of God.

It is on this foundation that I undertake this study on the great image that the Babylonian King Nebuchadnezzar dreamed about. Nebuchadnezzar had a dream that totally confounded him. He called for all the wise men of the nation to not only give him

the interpretation of the dream but he wanted them to tell him what he dreamt as well. None in Babylon and beyond was capable of such a thing so he ordered them to be executed. When Daniel heard about it he inquired of the Lord and God revealed the dream and gave the interpretation to Daniel. This is the record of Nebuchadnezzar's dream and the interpretation of it.

Daniel 2:31-43

[31] Thou, O king, sawest, and behold a great image. This great image, whose brightness was excellent, stood before thee; and the form thereof was terrible. [32] This image's head was of fine gold, his breast and his arms of silver, his belly and his thighs of brass, [33] His legs of iron, his feet part of iron and part of clay. [34] Thou sawest till that a stone was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet that were of iron and clay, and brake them to pieces. [35] Then was the iron, the clay, the brass, the silver, and the gold, broken to pieces together, and became like the chaff of the summer threshingfloors; and the wind carried them away, that no place was found for them: and the stone that smote the image became a great mountain, and filled the whole earth.

[36] This is the dream; and we will tell the interpretation thereof before the king. [37] Thou, O king, art a king of kings: for the God of heaven hath given thee a kingdom, power, and strength, and glory. [38] And wheresoever the children of men dwell, the beasts of the field and the fowls of the heaven hath he given into thine hand, and hath made thee ruler over them all. Thou art this head of gold. [39] And after thee shall arise another kingdom inferior to thee, and another third kingdom of brass, which shall bear rule over all the earth. [40] And the fourth kingdom shall be strong as iron: forasmuch as iron breaketh in pieces and subdueth all things: and as iron that breaketh all these, shall it break in pieces and bruise. [41] And whereas thou sawest the feet and toes, part of potters' clay, and part of iron, the kingdom shall be divided; but there shall be in it of the strength of the iron, forasmuch as thou sawest the iron mixed with miry clay. [42] And as the toes of the feet were part of iron, and part of clay, so the kingdom shall be partly strong, and partly broken. [43] And whereas thou sawest iron mixed with miry clay, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men: but they shall not cleave one to another, even as iron is not mixed with clay.

A great image with a head of gold, arm and breast made of silver, stomach and thigh made of brass, legs and part of the foot made of iron, and the rest of the feet and toes made of iron mixed with clay. Daniel goes on to say that the interpretation of the vision is that of four kingdoms each successive kingdom inferior to the other. A stone cut out of a mountain smote the feet of the image and it all crumbles because the iron and clay at the base were weak.

This dream has been, or I should say the traditional interpretation of this dream, is that these kingdoms are representative of the Babylonian Empire (gold), the Medo-Persia Empire (silver), The Greek Empire (brass), and the Roman Empire (iron), and the iron mixed with clay a weaker version of the Roman Empire. Any Bible College student would give this as the answer to the interpretation of this dream. It seems logical and historically it would seem that these empires fit the model interpretation of this dream. Before we draw a line in the sand and conclusively declare this to be the answer we should look at a few other passages that might support some thing vastly sinister and plausible, or if I might say a more accurate interpretation of this dream.

We begin our study in Genesis 6:1-7 which reads as follows, "And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born

unto them, That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose. And the Lord said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years. There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown. And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. And it repented the Lord that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart. And the Lord said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them.”

In this passage as is found throughout the Old Testament, the sons of God refers to angels. Angels are also referred to as watchers. The book of Daniel also refers to these angels, sons of God, as watchers. The term “watchers” is not an unfamiliar term to the Bible as seen in:

**Jeremiah 4:16**

Make ye mention to the nations; behold, publish against Jerusalem, that watchers come from a far country, and give out their voice against the cities of Judah.

**Daniel 4:13**

I saw in the visions of my head upon my bed, and, behold, a watcher and an holy one came down from heaven;

**Daniel 4:17**

This matter is by the decree of the watchers, and the demand by the word of the holy ones: to the intent that the living may know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will, and setteth up over it the basest of men.

**Daniel 4:23**

And whereas the king saw a watcher and an holy one coming down from heaven, and saying, Hew the tree down, and destroy it; yet leave the stump of the roots thereof in the earth, even with a band of iron and brass, in the tender grass of the field; and let it be wet with the dew of heaven, and let his portion be with the beasts of the field, till seven times pass over him;

This is a clear picture of the sons of God being angels, watchers. The text in Genesis goes on to say that the offspring's of the mixing of the angels and the daughters of men were the giants, Genesis 6:4. This was prior to the flood. The corruption of the earth with the descent of the sons of God was so extensive and total with the exception of Noah and his family. Verse 5, 7 and verse 12 of this same chapter states, “And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. ...And the Lord said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them....And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth.” The corruption of the earth with the influence of the sons of God affected every aspect of life on planet earth that it all had to be wiped out, “both man and beast.” Imagine that! What could man have possibly known or done to have polluted the earth so completely. “Man on his own accord did not eat from the fruit. Eve was influenced by the serpent. So man on the earth was not influenced by his own thoughts, he had outside influence from above, the sons of God.

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Not only was the race of man tainted by the DNA of the angels, but it would also appear that that DNA also tainted the other creatures of the earth, the beast, creeping things, and the fowls of the air. Psalm 82:5b states, "They know not, neither will they understand; they walk on in darkness: all the foundations of the earth are out of course." Do you recall looking at many of the statues that are in museums and history books of gods depicted as half man half beast? Such statues have been unearthed in just about every civilization on earth. That is how extensive the corruption of the earth was. But amidst all this, "Noah was a just man and perfect in his generation," Genesis 6:9b. Noah was referred to as perfect but this does not mean he was morally or religiously perfect. It means that Noah was not tainted; his bloodline and that of his family were untouched by angelic DNA. So God preserved Noah and his family to repopulate the earth with pure human DNA. Before the flood, that was the golden age of the mixing of the angelic and human race.

In Genesis 6:4 we note that "There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown. The verse is clear to state that giants were in the land before and after the flood. The one hundred and twenty years noted in the previous verse, Genesis 6:3 states, "And the Lord said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years." These are the 120 years that Noah took in preaching repentance and building the Ark, as you can see, before and after the flood. The sons of God came to the daughters of men and they bare them children before and after the flood.

The earth became polluted again but not to the extent that it was prior to the flood. They was a reason why God called Abraham. One of the reasons was to preserve the blood line that the enemy wanted to taint so the Messiah would not be able to come. Hence the strict recording of the genealogy of Israel from Adam through Jesus Christ the Messiah as noted in Matthew 1. Prior to the flood was the golden age or kingdom of the mixing of the race of man and angels. After the flood we see a less inferior age where the influence was not to the extent of prior to the flood. Giants were recorded through this age. (see verses listed under subtitle GIANTS previously noted. The Biblical accounts of giants take us through out the entire Old Testament and the book of Revelation. Another phrase used to reference giants is the term "mighty men." If you go back to the first time a word or phrase is used in the Bible that usually gives you the conclusive meaning or interpretation.

### MIGHTY MEN

#### **gibbowr, Hebrew 1368, Strong's**

**gibbowr**, *ghib-bore'*; or (shortened) **gibbor**, *ghib-bore'*; intensive from the same as Hebrew 1397 (*geber*); *powerful*; by implication *warrior, tyrant* :- champion, chief, x excel, giant, man, mighty (man, one), strong (man), valiant man.

#### Genesis 6:4

There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown.

#### Joshua 1:14

Your wives, your little ones, and your cattle, shall remain in the land which Moses gave you on this side Jordan; but ye shall pass before your brethren armed, all the mighty men of valour, and help them;

Joshua 6:2

And the Lord said unto Joshua, See, I have given into thine hand Jericho, and the king thereof, and the mighty men of valour.

Joshua 8:3

So Joshua arose, and all the people of war, to go up against Ai: and Joshua chose out thirty thousand mighty men of valour, and sent them away by night.

Joshua 10:7

So Joshua ascended from Gilgal, he, and all the people of war with him, and all the mighty men of valour.

1 Samuel 2:4

The bows of the mighty men are broken, and they that stumbled are girded with strength.

2 Samuel 10:7

And when David heard of it, he sent Joab, and all the host of the mighty men.

2 Samuel 16:6

And he cast stones at David, and at all the servants of king David: and all the people and all the mighty men were on his right hand and on his left.

2 Samuel 17:8

For, said Hushai, thou knowest thy father and his men, that they be mighty men, and they be chafed in their minds, as a bear robbed of her whelps in the field: and thy father is a man of war, and will not lodge with the people.

2 Samuel 20:7

And there went out after him Joab's men, and the Cherethites, and the Pelethites, and all the mighty men: and they went out of Jerusalem, to pursue after Sheba the son of Bichri.

2 Samuel 23:8-9

These be the names of the mighty men whom David had: The Tachmonite that sat in the seat, chief among the captains; the same was Adino the Eznite: he lift up his spear against eight hundred, whom he slew at one time. [9] And after him was Eleazar the son of Dodo the Ahohite, one of the three mighty men with David, when they defied the Philistines that were there gathered together to battle, and the men of Israel were gone away:

2 Samuel 23:16-17

And the three mighty men brake through the host of the Philistines, and drew water out of the well of Bethlehem, that was by the gate, and took it, and brought it to David: nevertheless he would not drink thereof, but poured it out unto the Lord. [17] And he said, Be it far from me, O Lord, that I should do this: is not this the blood of the men that

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went in jeopardy of their lives? therefore he would not drink it. These things did these three mighty men.

2 Samuel 23:22

These things did Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, and had the name among three mighty men.

1 Kings 1:8

But Zadok the priest, and Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, and Nathan the prophet, and Shimei, and Rei, and the mighty men which belonged to David, were not with Adonijah.

1 Kings 1:10

But Nathan the prophet, and Benaiah, and the mighty men, and Solomon his brother, he called not.

2 Kings 15:20

And Menahem exacted the money of Israel, even of all the mighty men of wealth, of each man fifty shekels of silver, to give to the king of Assyria. So the king of Assyria turned back, and stayed not there in the land.

2 Kings 24:14

And he carried away all Jerusalem, and all the princes, and all the mighty men of valour, even ten thousand captives, and all the craftsmen and smiths: none remained, save the poorest sort of the people of the land.

1 Chron. 5:24

And these were the heads of the house of their fathers, even Epher, and Ishi, and Eiel, and Azriel, and Jeremiah, and Hodaviah, and Jahdiel, mighty men of valour, famous men, and heads of the house of their fathers.

1 Chron. 7:7

And the sons of Bela; Ezbon, and Uzzi, and Uzziel, and Jerimoth, and Iri, five; heads of the house of their fathers, mighty men of valour; and were reckoned by their genealogies twenty and two thousand and thirty and four.

1 Chron. 7:9

And the number of them, after their genealogy by their generations, heads of the house of the fathers, mighty men of valour, was twenty thousand and two hundred.

1 Chron. 7:11

All these the sons of Jediel, by the heads of their fathers, mighty men of valour, were seventeen thousand and two hundred soldiers, fit to go out for war and battle.

1 Chron. 7:40

All these were the children of Asher, heads of their father's house, choice and mighty men of valour, chief of the princes. And the number throughout the genealogy of them that were apt to the war and to battle was twenty and six thousand men.

1 Chron. 8:40

And the sons of Ulam were mighty men of valour, archers, and had many sons, and sons' sons, an hundred and fifty. All these are of the sons of Benjamin.

1 Chron. 11:10-11

These also are the chief of the mighty men whom David had, who strengthened themselves with him in his kingdom, and with all Israel, to make him king, according to the word of the Lord concerning Israel. [11] And this is the number of the mighty men whom David had; Jashobeam, and Hachmonite, the chief of the captains: he lifted up his spear against three hundred slain by him at one time.

1 Chron. 12:1

Now these are they that came to David to Ziklag, while he yet kept himself close because of Saul the son of Kish: and they were among the mighty men, helpers of the war.

1 Chron. 12:21

And they helped David against the band of the rovers: for they were all mighty men of valour, and were captains in the host.

1 Chron. 12:25

Of the children of Simeon, mighty men of valour for the war, seven thousand and one hundred.

1 Chron. 12:30

And of the children of Ephraim twenty thousand and eight hundred, mighty men of valour, famous throughout the house of their fathers.

1 Chron. 19:8

And when David heard of it, he sent Joab, and all the host of the mighty men.

1 Chron. 26:6

Also unto Shemaiah his son were sons born, that ruled throughout the house of their father: for they were mighty men of valour.

1 Chron. 26:31

Among the Hebronites was Jerijah the chief, even among the Hebronites, according to the generations of his fathers. In the fortieth year of the reign of David they were sought for, and there were found among them mighty men of valour at Jazer of Gilead.

1 Chron. 28:1

And David assembled all the princes of Israel, the princes of the tribes, and the captains of the companies that ministered to the king by course, and the captains over the thousands, and captains over the hundreds, and the stewards over all the substance and possession of the king, and of his sons, with the officers, and with the mighty men, and with all the valiant men, unto Jerusalem.

1 Chron. 29:24

And all the princes, and the mighty men, and all the sons likewise of king David, submitted themselves unto Solomon the king.

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2 Chron. 13:3

And Abijah set the battle in array with an army of valiant men of war, even four hundred thousand chosen men: Jeroboam also set the battle in array against him with eight hundred thousand chosen men, being mighty men of valour.

2 Chron. 14:8

And Asa had an army of men that bare targets and spears, out of Judah three hundred thousand; and out of Benjamin, that bare shields and drew bows, two hundred and fourscore thousand: all these were mighty men of valour.

2 Chron. 17:13-14

And he had much business in the cities of Judah: and the men of war, mighty men of valour, were in Jerusalem. [14] And these are the numbers of them according to the house of their fathers: Of Judah, the captains of thousands; Adnah the chief, and with him mighty men of valour three hundred thousand.

2 Chron. 17:16

And next him was Amasiah the son of Zichri, who willingly offered himself unto the Lord; and with him two hundred thousand mighty men of valour.

2 Chron. 25:6

He hired also an hundred thousand mighty men of valour out of Israel for an hundred talents of silver.

2 Chron. 26:12

The whole number of the chief of the fathers of the mighty men of valour were two thousand and six hundred.

2 Chron. 32:3

He took counsel with his princes and his mighty men to stop the waters of the fountains which were without the city: and they did help him.

2 Chron. 32:21

And the Lord sent an angel, which cut off all the mighty men of valour, and the leaders and captains in the camp of the king of Assyria. So he returned with shame of face to his own land. And when he was come into the house of his god, they that came forth of his own bowels slew him there with the sword.

Neh. 11:14

And their brethren, mighty men of valour, an hundred twenty and eight: and their overseer was Zabdiel, the son of one of the great men.

Song 4:4

Thy neck is like the tower of David builded for an armoury, whereon there hang a thousand bucklers, all shields of mighty men.

Isaiah 21:17

And the residue of the number of archers, the mighty men of the children of Kedar, shall be diminished: for the Lord God of Israel hath spoken it.

Jeremiah 5:16

Their quiver is as an open sepulchre, they are all mighty men.

Jeremiah 26:21

And when Jehoiakim the king, with all his mighty men, and all the princes, heard his words, the king sought to put him to death: but when Urijah heard it, he was afraid, and fled, and went into Egypt;

Jeremiah 46:9

Come up, ye horses; and rage, ye chariots; and let the mighty men come forth; the Ethiopians and the Libyans, that handle the shield; and the Lydians, that handle and bend the bow.

Jeremiah 49:22

Behold, he shall come up and fly as the eagle, and spread his wings over Bozrah: and at that day shall the heart of the mighty men of Edom be as the heart of a woman in her pangs.

Jeremiah 50:36

A sword is upon the liars; and they shall dote: a sword is upon her mighty men; and they shall be dismayed.

Jeremiah 51:30

The mighty men of Babylon have forborn to fight, they have remained in their holds: their might hath failed; they became as women: they have burned her dwellingplaces; her bars are broken.

Jeremiah 51:56-57

Because the spoiler is come upon her, even upon Babylon, and her mighty men are taken, every one of their bows is broken: for the Lord God of recompences shall surely requite. [57] And I will make drunk her princes, and her wise men, her captains, and her rulers, and her mighty men: and they shall sleep a perpetual sleep, and not wake, saith the King, whose name is the Lord of hosts.

Lament. 1:15

The Lord hath trodden under foot all my mighty men in the midst of me: he hath called an assembly against me to crush my young men: the Lord hath trodden the virgin, the daughter of Judah, as in a winepress.

Ezekiel 39:20

Thus ye shall be filled at my table with horses and chariots, with mighty men, and with all men of war, saith the Lord God.

Hosea 10:13

Ye have plowed wickedness, ye have reaped iniquity; ye have eaten the fruit of lies: because thou didst trust in thy way, in the multitude of thy mighty men.

Joel 2:7

They shall run like mighty men; they shall climb the wall like men of war; and they shall march every one on his ways, and they shall not break their ranks:

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### Joel 3:9

Proclaim ye this among the Gentiles; Prepare war, wake up the mighty men, let all the men of war draw near; let them come up:

### Obadiah 1:9

And thy mighty men, O Teman, shall be dismayed, to the end that every one of the mount of Esau may be cut off by slaughter.

### Nahum 2:3

The shield of his mighty men is made red, the valiant men are in scarlet: the chariots shall be with flaming torches in the day of his preparation, and the fir trees shall be terribly shaken.

### Zech. 10:5

And they shall be as mighty men, which tread down their enemies in the mire of the streets in the battle: and they shall fight, because the Lord is with them, and the riders on horses shall be confounded.

### Rev. 6:15

And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;

### Rev. 19:18

That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.

Giants are found throughout history. Each age of descendants or the mingling of the race became less inferior to the other. Tradition tells us that the correct interpretation of Nebuchadnezzar's dream refers to political kingdoms. This is because we are programmed to look at things from a horizontal perspective. Each civilization has hieroglyphics depicting images of what we call aliens and other creatures that are half human half animal. This is seen more recently in Greek mythology as was in the Egyptian era. These creatures were worshipped as gods. If you look at history as gods go, the earlier records of gods were much more powerful than those at the time of the Greeks. Each age the gods depicted were noted as having less and less influence on humans and less power. I believe we are at the end of the Iron Age and the beginning of the iron/clay age. There is an increase of alien abductions more and more. These are not aliens, they are angelic beings. There are not coming from outer space they are coming from the spirit realm.

This is the work of the enemy that was started in Genesis 6 and continues today. We are looking for a political kingdom to appear with ten inferior kingdoms ruled by man. This is not the case, but rather angelic kingdom periods since before Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden. We should be looking historically at what I call the 'evolution of angels' as hybrids of man. Not evolution because man is evolving (we are created beings) but because the DNA of the angelic beings mixed with human DNA were becoming more human.

All through history they have been many anomalies. Might the Iron Age be the age of small Martian like creatures? Might not the iron and clay age be more true to human form as we hear all types of reports that they have been increases in humans being abducted by aliens and experimented on? If this is not plausible to you, then read the following verse found in Daniel 2:43. “And whereas thou sawest iron mixed with miry clay, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men: but they shall not cleave one to another, even as iron is not mixed with clay.” The iron is the seed of angels and clay being that of man. Clay as in ‘from dust we were formed.’ So what we have here, continuing in the interpretation of Daniel as given to him by God, is that the sons of God, angels, watchers, are continuing to mingle with the seed of men.

This clearly does not refer to a human political kingdom. It goes back to Genesis 6:4b “...the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them.” Remember, before and after the flood. The other reason to consider this image to be that of an angelic kingdom is because angelic appearances were not far fetch to the ancestors of man. Nebuchadnezzar was so familiar with these beings that when he saw the three Hebrew boys in the midst of the fire he stated quite clearly that in the midst of the fire was a form like the son of God (Daniel 3:25).

Further, in Nebuchadnezzar’s second recorded vision he stated, “I saw in the visions of my head upon my bed, and, behold, a watcher and an holy one came down from heaven; Daniel 4:13; and also in Daniel 4:17 he states, “This matter is by the decree of the watchers, and the demand by the word of the holy ones: to the intent that the living may know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will, and setteth up over it the basest of men.” The king did not wait for Daniel to tell him who was in his vision, he, the king, knew. Nebuchadnezzar was specific in relating his vision to Daniel. He said “the watchers.” Daniel confirmed this in Daniel 4:23, “And whereas the king saw a watcher and an holy one coming down from heaven, and saying...” It cannot be clearer than this. Angels were a common occurrence in Biblical times. They did not just appear to righteous men.

You say that this is not conclusive and that these kingdoms relate to angelic kingdom periods. Let’s look at what the scriptures note in relation to the worship of these beings or so call gods. Nebuchadnezzar’s dream is specific about the type of kingdoms: gold, silver, brass, iron, clay, sometime we see stone and wood.

Genesis 44:5, 8

Is not this it in which my lord drinketh, and whereby indeed he divineth? ye have done evil in so doing... Behold, the money, which we found in our sacks' mouths, we brought again unto thee out of the land of Canaan: how then should we steal out of thy lord's house silver or gold?

Exodus 20:23

Ye shall not make with me gods of silver, neither shall ye make unto you gods of gold.

Deut. 7:25

The graven images of their gods shall ye burn with fire: thou shalt not desire the silver or gold that is on them, nor take it unto thee, lest thou be snared therein: for it is an abomination to the Lord thy God.

Deut. 29:17

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And ye have seen their abominations, and their idols, wood and stone, silver and gold, which were among them:)

Joshua 7:21

When I saw among the spoils a goodly Babylonish garment, and two hundred shekels of silver, and a wedge of gold of fifty shekels weight, then I coveted them, and took them; and, behold, they are hid in the earth in the midst of my tent, and the silver under it.

Psalm 115:4

Their idols are silver and gold, the work of men's hands.

Psalm 135:15

The idols of the heathen are silver and gold, the work of men's hands.

Daniel 3:1

Nebuchadnezzar the king made an image of gold, whose height was threescore cubits, and the breadth thereof six cubits: he set it up in the plain of Dura, in the province of Babylon.

Daniel 5:4

They drank wine, and praised the gods of gold, and of silver, of brass, of iron, of wood, and of stone.

Hosea 2:8

For she did not know that I gave her corn, and wine, and oil, and multiplied her silver and gold, which they prepared for Baal.

Hosea 8:4

They have set up kings, but not by me: they have made princes, and I knew it not: of their silver and their gold have they made them idols, that they may be cut off.

Rev. 9:20

And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:

These are the very same elements used to make idols of since the very beginning. These elements were created by God specifically for His divine use. Joshua 6:19 states, "But all the silver, and gold, and vessels of brass and iron, are consecrated unto the Lord: they shall come into the treasury of the Lord." If we read in the book of Exodus we will see that all these materials were consecrated for use in the Tabernacle, the Temple, and the Ark of the Covenant. Satan is a counterfeiter.

In the above listed verses we see that gold, silver, brass, iron, wood, clay and stone were used to make vessels for the temple of God and by pagans for idols. King Belshazzar, Nebuchadnezzar's son, understood this well. "They drank wine, and praised the gods of gold, and of silver, of brass, of iron, of wood, and of stone" Daniel 5:4, and in Daniel 5:23, "But hast lifted up thyself against the Lord of heaven; and they have brought the vessels of his house before thee, and thou, and thy lords, thy wives,

and thy concubines, have drunk wine in them; and thou hast praised the gods of silver, and gold, of brass, iron, wood, and stone, which see not, nor hear, nor know: and the God in whose hand thy breath is, and whose are all thy ways, hast thou not glorified.”

Revelation 9:20 states, “And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk.” This is how gods were and still are defined as. They were angelic beings that were being worshipped as gods who fabricated idols that were representations of themselves.

It is clearly noted in the Old Testament who the sons of God are, that they are also referred to as angels, watchers, and mighty men. We also see that gold, silver, brass, iron, and clay also depict the worship of idols. It is further noted that angels were a common occurrence in the Old Testament. We also noted that these sons of God return to the earth after the flood and mixed with the race of men. The New Testament does not neglect this matter as we can see in the Book of Revelations. Nebuchadnezzar’s dream states that the iron and clay will mingle but not cling together.

Daniel 2:43 states, “And whereas thou sawest iron mixed with miry clay, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men: but they shall not cleave one to another, even as iron is not mixed with clay.” This last attempt of the angels to come to a final merging of their DNA with the human race will come to its final conclusion. This final attempt will fail. The DNA will not cleave. God said in Genesis as He created the earth and all that was in it, every thing after its own kind. Nothing but our own kind will cleave. Isn’t it interesting that we have such political pressures to do DNA research, clone, stem cell research, and produce babies by alternative means, and stock pile human embryos. This is not what God intended. We are altering the DNA of our food and steadily destroying our food resources. There is a rise in cancer, communicable diseases, and we are experiencing growing resistance to most of our antibiotics and immunizations, we have people suffering from mental health issues, the market is flooded with psychotropic medications, more and more children are being diagnosed with Attention Deficit Disorder and autism, and we can mass produce more and more products but most of the world is dying of starvation.

The book of Enoch (The book of Enoch is quoted in Jude) tells about the destruction of many of the giants before the flood. They turned on each other and many died at the hands of their own kind. We see a repeat of this in Revelations 6:4 “And there went out another horse that was red: and power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: (kill also as in for food – cannibalism) and there was given unto him a great sword.”

We see in Revelations 6:13 that they will be a great fall from heaven. “And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind.” It will not be aliens arriving to annihilate us as some might think. This is the wrath of God being poured out. “I have commanded my sanctified ones, I have also called my mighty ones for mine anger, even them that rejoice in my highness.” God declares that he will call forth those mixed with angelic DNA and human DNA to bring judgment.

Men who would not repent and even those that are mingled with angelic DNA will be in great fear. Revelation 6:14-16 states, “And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places. And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens

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and in the rocks of the mountains; And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb.”

Look at the description given in Revelation 9:6-11 “And in those days shall men **(CLAY)** seek death, and shall not find it; and shall desire to die, and death shall flee from them. And the shapes of the locusts were like unto horses prepared unto battle; and on their heads were as it were crowns like gold, and their faces were as the faces of men **(IRON and CLAY)**. And they had hair as the hair of women, and their teeth were as the teeth of lions. And they had breastplates, as it were breastplates of iron; and the sound of their wings was as the sound of chariots of many horses running to battle. And they had tails like unto scorpions, and there were stings in their tails: and their power was to hurt men **(CLAY)** five months. And they had a king over them, which is the angel **(IRON)** of the bottomless pit, whose name in the Hebrew tongue is Abaddon, but in the Greek tongue hath his name Apollyon.

So, this great image of Nebuchadnezzar is not referring to a political kingdom of men. It is referring to kingdoms of angelic influence. We are living in an age where knowledge is abounding at an astronomical rate. No sooner a computer chip is out and it must be upgraded in a matter of months. Look at the discoveries we are making in record time. We see in a glass darkly. We have learned to spiritualize the word of God and rely on the traditions of men to tell us what the word of God means. Evil is lurking amongst us and we fail to see why the believer must not be unequally yoked to the unbeliever. There is a reason why there is a hedge around us. We have breached the hedge and now the tares have infiltrated the wheat. We have goats in with the sheep, and the wolves are attacking. This is why the lost are desperate to be saved. They see in their darkness clearly. They know what we do not know and we perish for a lack of knowledge. We were told to have dominion of all that was on the earth but we because of sin gave our dominion over to Satan. This battle is for dominion that was given to man. We shall have dominion once again under the rule and reign of Jesus Christ.

If you don't accept the penning of these words then at least do yourself a favor and do some research on your own, but for goodness sakes, don't just shove this one to the side. Do the research. At least you have made an informed decision. Don't perish for a lack of knowledge. We live in the age of the internet. It is all available at a click. Remember, the Bible is our foundation and everything we read should be filtered through the Bible.

## Chapter 3

### The Four Beasts

Daniel also had a dream, a night vision, recorded in Daniel Chapter 7. This dream refers to the kingdoms of angels. This dream was not a repetition of Nebuchadnezzar's dream, in Chapter 2 but a conclusion of his dream. We only need to look at Ezekiel's description of the angelic beings that he saw by the river of Chebar to recognize that Daniel's beasts are not representative of the kingdoms of man but that of angels.

Ezekiel 1:5-11.

"[5] Also out of the midst thereof came the likeness of four living creatures. And this was their appearance; they had the likeness of a man. [6] And every one had four faces, and every one had four wings. [7] And their feet were straight feet; and the sole of their feet was like the sole of a calf's foot: and they sparkled like the colour of burnished brass. [8] And they had the hands of a man under their wings on their four sides; and they four had their faces and their wings. [9] Their wings were joined one to another; they turned not when they went; they went every one straight forward. [10] As for the likeness of their faces, they four had the face of a **man**, and the face of a **lion**, on the right side: and they four had the face of an **ox** on the left side; they four also had the face of an **eagle**. [11] Thus were their faces: and their wings were stretched upward; two wings of every one were joined one to another, and two covered their bodies"

Daniel's vision was a final picture of the destruction of the angelic kingdom as we will see in Daniel 7. "Daniel spake and said, I saw in my vision by night, and, behold, the four winds of the heaven strove upon the great sea" Daniel 7:2. This scene is to be realized in Revelations 7:1 "And after these things I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree." Then Daniel relates what he sees next, "And four great beasts came up from the sea, diverse one from another" Daniel 7:3. This will be realized in Revelation 9:14, "Saying to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, Loose the four angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates."

Daniel then gives a description of the four beasts. "[4] The first was like a **lion**, and had eagle's wings: I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it. [5] And behold another beast, a second, like to a **bear**, and it raised up itself on one side, and it had three ribs in the mouth of it between the teeth of it: and they said thus unto it, Arise, devour much flesh. [6] After this I beheld, and lo another, like a **leopard**, which had upon the back of it four wings of a fowl; the beast had also four heads; and dominion was given to it. [7] After this I saw in the night visions, and behold a fourth beast, dreadful and terrible, and strong exceedingly; and it had great *iron* teeth it devoured and brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with the feet of it: and it was diverse from all the beasts that were before it; and it had ten horns. [8] I considered the horns, and, behold, there came up among them another little horn, before whom there were three of the first horns plucked up by the roots: and, behold, in this horn were **eyes like the eyes of man**, and a mouth speaking great things" Daniel 7:4-8. There cannot be any clearer indication that these are angels Daniel is speaking of and not political

kingdoms. Our traditional notions have us so blinded we can not see what is plainly before us. We have learned too well how to spiritualize the word of God.

Isn't it interesting that the description of some of the beast mentioned in the bible often have a face or some attribute or feature of man? Also we find that they have attributes of living creatures combined. That should be proof enough that the enemy of God is attempting to duplicate God's masterpieces as we can see from ancient pictures of half man half beast beings. Satan is a counterfeiter. Yet the only thing he is capable of doing is manipulate what God has already created. It is clear that as we ponder the description of these beast, something sinister appears in light of the mingling of the species.

These four beasts are those that Jude refers to who did not keep their first estate. "And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day" Jude 6. They will be loosed in the last days at the appointed time as noted in Revelation 9:14 "Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the four angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates." These are those that are being loosed at this appointed time in Revelation 9. These four beasts are the kings of the angelic kingdoms who first polluted the earth with their seed. They will make a final stance. They will manipulate the final angelic kingdom of iron mingled with clay to wipe out humanity but they will not succeed because the two shall not cleave.

Before we take a look at the interpretation given to Daniel let's look at the conclusion of his vision. We see this kingdom broken by the Ancient of days (Jehovah God). Daniel 7:8-9 is clear, "I considered the horns, and, behold, there came up among them another little horn, before whom there were three of the first horns plucked up by the roots: and, behold, in this horn were eyes like the eyes of man, and a mouth speaking great things. I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne was like the fiery flame and his wheels as burning fire." The angelic thrones will be cast down by Jesus the King of Kings and Lord of Lords.

In Daniel 7:10-14 we see the little horn rising above the other horns and three of the ten having been devoured and broken in pieces. A beast will appear speaking great things. But in Daniel 7:11 it will be destroyed. "I beheld then because of the voice of the great words which the horn spake: I beheld even till the beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame." Next in verse 12 we see that the rest of the beasts have their dominion taken away. "As concerning the rest of the beasts, they had their dominion taken away: yet their lives were prolonged for a season and time." Verses 13 and 14 concludes with the Son of man coming back to the earth with the cloud of heaven to take dominion of the earth that Adam had lost in the Garden of Eden. Christ the last Adam will take back what the first Adam lost. The kingdom must be taken back from the angels that deceitfully stole it. Christ is not taking the kingdom back from man He is taking it back for man. We were told to have dominion of the earth and now through Christ we shall have dominion on the earth with Christ as King of Kings. "[13] I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. [14] And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed. Daniel 7:13-14.

The kingdom must be taken back from the angels who stole it by deception and corruption of every kind. Genesis 6:12 is clear, "And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth. " All flesh is

inclusive of man, beast, fowls of the air and creeping things. Creatures that were not tainted by the angelic line and Noah and his family who were untainted were preserved in the ark to begin again.

Now let us look at the interpretation given to Daniel. Daniel 7:17 begins the interpretation by specifying who the beasts represents. "These great beasts, which are four, are four kings, which shall arise out of the earth." Out of the earth means exactly that! These are angelic kings that are locked in the earth shut up in the sea great Euphrates. Revelation 9:14 is clear, "Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the four angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates."

Daniel 7:18 reveals who the beasts are and is clear in stating that the kingdom will be taken from the four beasts (angels) and returned to the saints. "But the saints of the most High shall take the kingdom, and possess the kingdom for ever, even for ever and ever." The kingdom was usurped from man and this is what the entire history has been about, Paradise lost in Genesis and Paradise regained in Revelation. The final chapter of this book speaks about how man lost dominion and under what circumstance we will regain it.

Therefore, we are not speaking here about a political system of man. We are not speaking of man against man; we are speaking here about a war for the souls of man and the utter destruction of man. This is diabolical. While we are spinning our wheels looking to the European system and the Pope as the antichrist and so forth, the enemy is getting stronger and gaining a foot hold. The bible is clear, "For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places" Ephesians 6:12. Do you see! This is not a kingdom of man against a kingdom of man. It is a battle between the fallen angels and man.

These are kings that will rise up against the Ancient of days, Jehovah, Elohim. This is a battle that started long before man was created and placed in the Garden. Satan tried to take God's kingdom in the heavenlies and when he could not he usurped ours. Look at Daniel 7:23, "Thus he said, The fourth beast shall be the fourth kingdom upon earth, which shall be diverse from all kingdoms, and shall devour the whole earth, and shall tread it down, and break it in pieces. " The four beasts shall be "the fourth kingdom," the fourth kingdom of the angelic dominion on the earth. Ten kings shall rise out of the fourth kingdom. Daniel 7:24 shows this, "And the ten horns out of this kingdom are ten kings that shall arise: and another shall rise after them; and he shall be diverse from the first, and he shall subdue three kings." These angelic being will fight amongst themselves. We have several battles going on her it would seem, Satan for ultimate power, and the descended watchers for dominion. There is no honor among thieves. Satan will interject his Anti-Christ that will subdue three of the ten kings. "And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time" Daniel 7:25. This is Satan's final stance. Remember his words recorded in Isaiah 14:14, "I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High." Exactly what Daniel 7:25 states, "And he shall speak great words against the most High."

The interpretation goes on declare the end of Satan's dominion. "But the judgment shall sit, **and they shall take away his dominion**, to consume and to destroy it unto the end" Daniel 7:26. Satan's final play for authority in heaven and dominion on the earth are final destroyed. Now look at what happen with this dominion that the enemy stole from man, "And **the kingdom and dominion**, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, **shall be given to the people of the saints of the**

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**most High**, whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him” Daniel 7:27. The kingdom and dominion shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High. We shall regain it all. It “shall be given” means exactly that, it shall be given to us. You can not be given what you already have. If the kingdoms spoken of in these dreams are the kingdoms of men than why say it shall be given to when we already have it. We lost the kingdom and the dominion and now we shall have it back.

Ezekiel 28:13-19 clarifies this entire matter. “Ezekiel 28:13-16 “[13] Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God; every precious stone was thy covering, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created. [14] Thou art the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee so: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire. [15] Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee. [16] By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire. [17] Thine heart was lifted up because of thy beauty, thou hast corrupted thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: I will cast thee to the ground, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee. [18] Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries by the multitude of thine iniquities, by the iniquity of thy traffick; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee. [19] All they that know thee among the people shall be astonished at thee: thou shalt be a terror, and never shalt thou be any more.” This is where it all began and this is where it all shall end.

There is much more to be learned about these dreams if you will only take the time to study the word of God. You have nothing to fear in learning the truth. The enemy is still pulling the strings and we are glad to oblige him by remaining ignorant. We have been given a map to the enemy’s plans but we do not care to see. We know how he will attack but we rather reinvent the wheel so we do not see what is truly there. We are contented to say we are saved by grace. Yet we remain ignorant as to what grace has given us access to. Get rid of your notions and traditions and see, really see what God has preserved for us in His word. The enemy is diabolical and cunning. Our battle is not flesh and blood. When you find thinks out about the word, please do not keep it a secret. God’s revealed word is for all not just some. For some it is an instrument of control and authority. All authority belongs to Christ.

Jude 1:7

Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after **strange flesh**, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.

The word “strange” found in this verse is not referring to strange as in stranger or foreigner – it refers to strange as in “uncertain affinity.” It really means that they were no human resemblance noted. Jude is speaking concerning the men of Sodom and Gomorrah who were forcibly attempting to have sexual relations with the angels that visited Lot in the city prior to the destruction of the two cities. The angels are referred to as “strange flesh.”

The word “strange” is often used in referring to people of foreign nations or with foreign customs. In Jude however, the word “strange” is clearly referring to flesh that was not human in nature. To assume that the sons of God could not have sexual relations with the daughters of men would not be supported by this verse in Jude.

Jude 1:6

And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own **habitation**, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.

The word habitation in this verse means residence. The angels, watchers, sons of God, fallen stars, left their heavenly habitation to cohabit with the daughters of men. They were “strange flesh” to the daughters of men and thus produced the Nephilim race. This race of people noted in Genesis 6 as giants of renown. It would be impossible for the children of Cain having cohabited with the daughters of Seth, the righteous line to produce a race that was of a different kind. God said be fruitful and multiply each after their kind. Obviously, angels mingled with the daughters of men would not produce after their own kind, but rather a different kind since these are two radically different species spirit and flesh.

Genesis 1:21

And God created great whales, and every living creature that moveth, which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind, and every winged fowl after his kind: and God saw that it was good.

Genesis 1:24-25

And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind: and it was so. And God made the beast of the earth after his kind, and cattle after their kind, and every thing that creepeth upon the earth after his kind: and God saw that it was good.

It is interesting that God stated “after his kind” in reference to each creature, fishes, animals, and fowls, but it was not stated so when man was created. Rather God created a woman for man out of his ribs, bone of his bone and flesh of his flesh. The flesh of Eve was not strange flesh to Adam; it was the exact same and likeness. The other creatures were brought forth from the earth and the water. Although Adam was

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also formed of the dust of the ground, he was given something unique that the other creatures were not given, a soul, God breathed. God also said that when man and woman are joined together they shall be “one flesh.” (See also Matthew 10:4-8)

Angels are not flesh, they are spirit (Psalm 104:4 “Who maketh his angels spirits; his ministers a flaming fire,” and Mark 12:25 “For when they shall rise from the dead, they neither marry, nor are given in marriage; but are as the angels which are in heaven”) even though they have the ability to materialize as flesh and blood. Matthew 22:30 states, “For in the resurrection they neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are as the angels of God in heaven.” Angels were never intended to co-habit. They are not given in marriage. Would that be because they are all males? Did not God take the woman out of Adam’s body? God originally house the person of woman in Adam and so when Adam indicated that there was none found among the creatures of the earth for him, God put him to sleep and from Adam’s rib which he took out, He made Adam a woman, male and female he created them.

In all likelihood, the angelic form housed only the male species of angels and so they would have been no wives for them to have. So, they turned their attention to the daughters of men. They took to them selves wives from the daughters of men. Angels are referred to as “sons” of God, and none took husbands from the seed of Adam because it is obvious that they are males in gender.

Jesus was presented to man in the form of man and not in the form of angels. Hebrews 2:16 “For verily he took not on him the nature of angels; but he took on him the seed of Abraham.” These are two separate kinds, man and angels. It is clear that God created man and woman for reproduction. Genesis 1:27 “So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them, “and Genesis 5:2 “Male and female created he them; and blessed them, and called their name Adam, in the day when they were created.” When God preserved Noah and his family and two of every living creature, He was very specific in noting that they were “of all flesh” and not spirit that was being preserved.

### Genesis 7:9

There went in two and two unto Noah into the ark, the male and the female, as God had commanded Noah.

### Genesis 7:16

And they that went in, went in male and female **of all flesh**, as God had commanded him: and the Lord shut him in.

It is important for the church to be aware of all of God’s word and its true meaning as we approach the latter days. Hosea 4:6 “My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.” Is this any different from the time of Israel’s early days? We have rejected God’s word, spiritualizing it, rejecting the truths that are therein, we have forgotten His laws, and we have forgotten to pass on our faith to our children. The Bible has become a myth to many believers and tall tales to the unbelievers. Matthew 24:13 states, “But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.” How can one endure what one perceives as a myth?

Matthew 24:37-38 states, “But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and

drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark." All will be the same as in the days of Noah. Remember Genesis 6:

Genesis 6:1-13

[1] And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them, [2] That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose. [3] And the Lord said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years. [4] There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown.

[5] And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. [6] And it repented the Lord that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart. [7] And the Lord said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them. [8] But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord.

[9] These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God. [10] And Noah begat three sons, Shem, Ham, and Japheth. [11] The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence. [12] And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth. [13] And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.

## Chapter 5 In Their Own Image

The “sons of God” as mentioned in Genesis 6:2 clearly is a reference to angelic beings. They wanted to make man in their own image; to them this would be their crowning glory, to be as gods. Nothing happens without a reason. Solomon says there is a purpose for everything under the sun. Therefore the sons of God had their purpose as well. It wasn’t just that the daughters of men were fair, but rather that “they took them wives of all which they chose” Genesis 6:2. It would appear that they were selective in the daughters of men. Not just any woman would do so to speak.

“For that he also is flesh” Genesis 6:3b. He also is, was prefaced by “My spirit shall not always strive with man” Genesis 6:3a. Man at this point had become spirit and flesh as well. The seed of man had become so corrupted by the sons of God, the seed of the serpent, that the bloodline had become tainted and man was not just flesh, man had become spirit and flesh. This is apart from God creating man as body, soul, and spirit. This spirit that was now mingled with flesh was pure spirit, sons of God. Man’s body was impacted in several ways. His body by enormous growth DNA, giants, and his mind was impacted by knowledge, imagination and wickedness, and his spirit by gaining access to the supernatural realm: fortune tellers, seers, star gazers, etc.

“But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord. These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God” Genesis 6:8-9. “Noah was perfect” means that Noah in his generation was not tainted by the mingling of DNA of the sons of God. It so repented God that He made man upon the earth because the sons of God had corrupted all flesh. Genesis 6:7 states, “And the Lord said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them.” All flesh being corrupted by the sons of God included man, beast, creeping things, and fowls of the air. There was a reason why God selected two of every kind to come into the ark. Those creatures that were not tainted were selected as was Noah and his family to survive the flood.

We know that these sons of God were not just here on the earth before the flood but also after the flood as well. “There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown” Genesis 6:4. So we see that with the mingling of the sons of God and daughters of men they produced giants as their offspring. Genesis 6:12 is very clear on the extent of the mingling, “And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth,” “both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air” Genesis 6:7. The sons of God left no flesh untouched. I believe this is why we have animals that are extinct after the flood, that flesh that was corrupted did not make it aboard the ark.

All through history there are stories told of giants, half-man half-animal creatures, and so called gods visiting mortals. The stories are pervasive in all cultures. Cultures that have not been together since the Tower of Babel still tell the oral stories from when man was all one language. This is also truth of remote countries had their visitation of gods and strange creatures at various times in history as well. It would seem that they have never left us. As each nation came out of their isolation from the rest of the earth, they came with their own stories. Their own stories were telltale signs that, where the

enemy can isolate man, they have wreck havoc. They never left us, these sons of God. I believe they have been influencing humanity in a peripheral way. The mingling had already taken place but the results were obvious, giants of renown. It was obvious who were of the mingled seed and who were not. I think that the more subtle approach has been in effect for centuries. The offspring are manipulated down to normal size individuals except for on the occasion when the primordial gene seem to escape where in we see the occasional through backs or strangely deformed fetus.

The manifestations are no longer physical characteristics, as they once were. Have you wondered why technology is improving by leaps and bounds? There is nothing that man have not imagine that he has not brought to pass. Have you learned to think in imaginative terms? Look at our school systems. They have introduced meditation, imagination, transcendental thinking rather than cognitive and rational thinking, and by visualization. We have been programmed to arrive at this juncture in time. We have learned to spiritualize everything and question nothing. Even though there is a train heading right at us doing 2,000 miles an hours we see nothing. We say that is not a train, it is just a beam of light. That it is not the sound of a train coming that is the thunder sounding before the lightening.

Embedded into the DNA of some individuals is the seed of the serpent. It is just waiting for the season when all things possible will be believed and pursued without question. The seeping out of primordial genes are the telltale signs that something is wrong. Do you see what I am saying? They are among us, there never left, before and after the flood. The Bible is not a book of myths; it is a historical book on facts and truth. Do you really believe that nations separated by various un-traversable land topographies can all have had the same hallucinations? Is it possible? We were scattered abroad at the point of the Tower of Babel because God knew that when man converge together his imagination becomes hell bent. Why do you think the enemy desires a one world nation? The enemy knows that humanity on a common level is capable of one thing, the same as it was at Babel, attempting to ascend to heaven to be as gods.

The one endeavor all world nations all agree on and will in a heart beat cooperate on is exploration of space, the final frontier. In other word, in search of God so they can be as gods, is our ultimate desire. This is the point in which humanity will meet at the same level, at the quest to be as gods. Why do you think religions blend, merge, and mingle? It is always at the point where another religion claims they have found the way to becomes as gods. This is the world in which the lost are caught up in. It is at the point of accomplishment. If a mixture of this and that can get me there faster, so be it. The truth is they believe the lies. They are blinded to truth because they are hell bent on a quest for immortality, and the godhead. But God already offers this to us through the shed blood of His Son Jesus Christ. He has already given us the opportunity to enter into His grace and to partake in eternity. But it is as His sons and daughters, not His equal. There is none beside God.

Do you see what the enemy is trying to accomplish. He attempted the same coup and failed. He was thrown out of heaven with one third of the heavenly host. So what if he takes a third of humanity with him to hell, he doesn't care. God always told the children of Israel not to intermarry with the pagans. He was attempting to keep the Israelites untainted and perfect. This is why DNA can determine if you are Jewish and which tribe you are from. For the most part, Israel remained a pure race. But there were those that did not keep God's commandments and gave their daughters and sons in marriage to the pagans. Do you see why God was always giving genealogies in the Bible? Those are the chapters we hate to read with names we can hardly pronounce.

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But these are there for a reason. As we trace from Adam to Christ we can see the perfect bloodline. Although we see a few that were not Hebrew such as Ruth, and Rehab we know that these were women that converted totally to the Hebrew way of life. God said that if the strangers came in among them that the men were to be circumcised. This would be a guarantee that they were not tainted. Is this not the same reason the Church is told not to be unequally yoked with the unbeliever.

Can you see how God's commandments have been constructed to protect us? Jesus' blood redeems us from the curse of the serpent. Can you see that God offers the church the same protection as He did Israel? The tares and the wheat are growing together. The tainted seed and untainted seeds are growing together. Matthew 13:24-30 states, "Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, The kingdom of heaven is likened unto a man which sowed good seed in his field: But while men slept, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat, and went his way. But when the blade was sprung up, and brought forth fruit, then appeared the tares also. So the servants of the householder came and said unto him, Sir, didst not thou sow good seed in thy field? from whence then hath it tares? He said unto them, An enemy hath done this. The servants said unto him, Wilt thou then that we go and gather them up? But he said, Nay; lest while ye gather up the tares, ye root up also the wheat with them. Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into my barn."

Jesus gives the interpretation of this parable as recorded in Matthew 13:37-43. "He answered and said unto them, He that soweth the good seed is the Son of man; The field is the world; the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked one; The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels. As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be in the end of this world. The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity; And shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth. Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Who hath ears to hear, let him hear."

"And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud one sat like unto the Son of man, having on his head a golden crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle. And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe. And he that sat on the cloud thrust in his sickle on the earth; and the earth was reaped. [And another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle. And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe. And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God. And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs" Revelation 14:14-20.

Our tendency is to spiritualize everything we read in the word of God because it is our comfort zone. Yet, God's word cannot lie. His word will neither return to Him void. God's word is clear, there are two seeds growing together, the seed of the serpent and the seed of the woman. Genesis 3:15 states, "And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt

bruise his heel. This is not a fairytale. At the telling of this prophecy, Satan determined that if the seed of woman became tainted then the promise Messiah could not come forth. But God, having wisdom before the foundations of this world preserved Noah and his family and the future generations unto the time of Christ. Even Herod motivated by the lies of Satan tried to kill the infant Jesus and failed. God preserved the seed of the woman. This has always been about Satan trying to shape the seed of the woman in his own image to defy God. Nothing has changed. Evil has only become sophisticated. Deception has gone underground and emerged glamorous and appealing to men. There are those I have met in my lifetime that perplexed me. I saw in a glass darkly but now I see clearly. Have you ever been in the presence of someone who would not even approach a Bible or further more touch one? They seem to have abhorrence for the things of God. I knew such a person in recent times that would not even so much as touch my daily devotional book. They would seem to coil up.

There is a presence in the world that has long been here along side man. It is not a kind presence, but one that is in constant conflict with man. It is time we open our eyes and see things for what they are and what they be. One only need to open up the bible and read with understanding that which has always been there yet distorted by our perceptions based on tradition, religiousness, and ignorance. We have no one to blame for our deception but ourselves. At least not in this day and age where we have access to what is happening in the world at the click of a mouse. Just read the Bible. Open the book and read. Let God open the eyes of your understanding so you can walk in truth. Stop dismissing the stories of giants in the Bible as myths, stop spiritualizing the parting of the Red Sea, the three Hebrew boys walking in the midst of the fire, Daniel in the lions den, Jesus healing the sick and the apostles laying on of hands. Soon the Bible will all just be a fable to be told at bedtime. Wake up, they are amongst us in our image trying to shape us in their image.

“And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them” Genesis 1:26-27. It is God's image we are created in. The serpent was not and will not be God, he was merely “more subtil than any beast of the field which the Lord God had made” Genesis 3:1a. And this is what he is capable of, “And the woman said, The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat” Genesis 3:13b. Do you see that we are still being beguiled? Whose image do you want to be in? It is still your choice. For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved” John 3:16-17. This is what our loving heavenly Father has done for us. So, live in His image so the enemy cannot corrupt God's image in you.

One mistake I find that preachers and teachers do to enable the body of Christ is to spoon feed them everything and so they are easily deceived. Strong's Concordance is a great study tool that will help you to study in-depth topics of the Bible. More than this, if you would only open the Bible and begin to read, meticulously read, you will begin to see truths in the Bible that have been over looked or spiritualized. You must read from cover to cover to get a complete understanding of the Bible. Also, a good Hebrew and Greek study Bible will assist you in comprehending further. And of course there is no one that will reveal the word of God to you better than the Holy Spirit.

## Chapter 6 What John Saw

We have become so complacent, we have no idea what is to come. It is not what we think or suspect. It is by far a greater ordeal than we anticipate for the latter days. It is soon upon us and we are clueless. They will fall, the stars will fall from the heaven, but they will not. They will come, bringing war and destruction, and the end of days will be shortened for the elect's sake. What John saw is indiscernible to us for we cannot comprehend the things that John saw in his vision. I also thought that only time could bring understanding to John's vision of things he could not describe for these were strange to him. What John saw, he saw! We cannot see what is written so plainly. It is so frightening and beyond our thinking that we refuse to give into what is to come. We must give in to the reality of what John saw. We must see what he saw in light of heaven and earth, the invisible and the visible things of this world tells us that the heaven and earth will be shaken.

Matthew 24:29

Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, **and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken:**

Luke 21:25-26

And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring; **Men's hearts failing them for fear**, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken.

2 Thessalonians 2:2

**That ye be not soon shaken in mind**, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.

Hebrews 12:27

And this word, **Yet once more, signifieth the removing of those things that are shaken, as of things that are made, that those things which cannot be shaken may remain.**

Revelation 6:13

**And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth**, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind.

Strange things will happen on the earth just as John saw in his vision of the last days. The world will be as you have never seen or imagine it to be, as in the days of Noah. Pick up the Bible and begin to read with a renewed mind and with understanding, putting away from you all preconceived notions. Stop managing world news events and orchestrating a world order that is clearly out of the scope of your perception. Look at it from God's supernatural point of view. There will be a conglomeration of powers, the natural and the supernatural. So you have learned to spiritualize the spirit world! Both the heaven and the earth shall be shaken. Hebrews 12:25-26 states "See that ye refuse not him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth,

much more shall not we escape, if we turn away from him that speaketh from heaven: Whose voice then shook the earth: but now he hath promised, saying, Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven.” Don’t you realize, “For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places” Ephesians 6:12.

So, in actuality, John’s vision was not so strange to him. For certain, it put fear in him. Imagine John being terrified of his vision and how we have painted such a neat picture of what he saw of what is to come. Japan has lived through an atomic bomb and as devastating as that was, what is to come is by far greater than fear of what man can do to man. We will see the visible and the invisible do battle on the earth. We will see incredible sights that not even sci-fi television can dream up. Think of the worst movie you have ever seen and imagine a hundred or more times greater. **“Men’s hearts failing them for fear,** and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth.” You’ve only to read Ezekiel, Daniel, and Revelation to see the enormity of what is to come.

I believe John saw familiar things and unfamiliar things. In John’s time supernatural things were still an occurrence. Remember the things that Jesus did and all the eyewitnesses of them? Remember the heavenly host that sang to the shepherds concerning the arrival of the Messiah? Remember the miracles of Jesus and the apostles? All these things were natural in John’s time. Acts 5:15 states, “Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them.” The people of John’s time expected that the very shadow of Peter would heal. The early church experienced the visible and invisible things of the world. Today, most people will not acknowledge that there is a God and so we have dismissed all the relevant and pertinent things of the Bible. We have no vision of God. “Where there is no vision, the people perish” Proverbs 29:18a. If you are going to perish, don’t perish out of ignorance.

Study the Word! Study the Word! Study the Word! It is all there in black and white and some red. Many believers can tell you the words of the latest Christian song but few can quote the Bible or defend their faith. It is up to each and every one of us to pursue our faith. Your pastor cannot make the Bible relevant to you if God is not relevant to you. He/she cannot convince you of the truth of all of God’s word if He is only a sometime God to you. John saw what he saw. What do you see? What do you really know? If you are just going along with the popular teachings of the day and not reading the word of God for yourself, woe is you. Rise up off your bed of spiritual ignorance and pursue the Lord’s agenda for your latter days. Habakkuk 2:3 “For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.

## Chapter 7 The Kingdom Of Men

Daniel 4:17

This matter is by the decree of the watchers, and the demand by the word of the holy ones: to the intent that the living may know that **the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men**, and giveth it to whomsoever he will, and setteth up over it the basest of men.

Daniel 4:25

That they shall drive thee from men, and thy dwelling shall be with the beasts of the field, and they shall make thee to eat grass as oxen, and they shall wet thee with the dew of heaven, and seven times shall pass over thee, till thou know that the **most High ruleth in the kingdom of men**, and giveth it to whomsoever he will.

Daniel 4:32

And they shall drive thee from men, and thy dwelling shall be with the beasts of the field: they shall make thee to eat grass as oxen, and seven times shall pass over thee, until thou know that **the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men**, and giveth it to whomsoever he will.

Daniel 5:21

And he was driven from the sons of men; and his heart was made like the beasts, and his dwelling was with the wild asses: they fed him with grass like oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven; till he knew that **the most high God ruled in the kingdom of men**, and that he appointeth over it whomsoever he will.

These verses do not only refer to King Belshazzar but it is also prophetic concerning the end times and what is to come. In order to understand these verses, one must do a through study of the Bible from Genesis to Revelation. You must understand how the watchers descended in Genesis 6 and how after the flood there were once again giants in the land because they was a mixing before the flood and after the flood of the sons of God and the daughters of men - one kingdom mingling with another. Daniel 2:43 states, "And whereas thou sawest iron mixed with miry clay, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men: but they shall not cleave one to another, even as iron is not mixed with clay." Further research will show that iron is to angels as clay is to men. (See other articles posted)

The fallen and their descendants are driven from men and will once again rise up to come against mankind in a final battle forged on deception. They will come in a mighty way against the nation of Israel and against the world which will unite to fight against them. They will try to fight with weapons of war that will be to no avail. The Bible tells us that our battle is not against flesh and blood but against principalities. You must fight spirit with spirit. This is why God says that we must be holy as He is holy. Only holiness will keep the enemy from our door.

They will try to mingle once again, but the iron and clay will not cleave. Iron, angels, watchers, nephilims, and stars are all words used to convey angelic beings. They are gathering their host together for the last and final battle. But the kingdom of men need not fear because the Most High God is on our side. He stands with the

kingdom of men. Jeremiah 15:12 is clear; "Shall iron break the northern iron and the steel?" Spiritually speaking for man, iron sharpens iron. In other words we must encourage each other in the word. When God gives us a truth we must share it with others lest it falls by the wayside. In the case of the fallen angelic host, iron will break iron. We can resist the devil and he will flee from us and no weapon formed against us shall prosper. We are to take a stand for God and stand on the side of righteousness. We are told to stand because the battle is not ours it is the Lord's.

So many of us try to do the work that belongs to God and so we become entangle in the yoke of bondage to the enemy. We attempt to go into the enemy's territory pulling down what only Jesus Himself is capable of doing. We think we are in a position to offer God inferior offerings. God says stand and we say go to battle. What God says is what He means. God says that Jesus shall return with the host of the holy angels and defeat the enemy once and for all.

Matthew 25:31

When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory:

Mark 8:38

Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he cometh in the glory of his Father with the holy angels.

Luke 9:26

For whosoever shall be ashamed of me and of my words, of him shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he shall come in his own glory, and in his Father's, and of the holy angels.

Rev. 14:10

The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:

The ultimate battle will be fought by Jesus and the holy angels – they are the 2/3 that did not fall with Lucifer. The battle is not ours, it is the Lord's. False prophets are going around rallying the believers to do strange things that the Bible does not tell us to do. They are reading into the text whatever they feel that sounds good to them. Everything that sounds good is not good or from the Lord.

God gave Adam and Eve a simply commandment that was intended to keep the evil one at bay so they succumb and fell into sin. Then He gave Moses two stones with Ten Commandments probably made out of clay that was meant to break iron. In other words, if you keep my commandments, the enemy will flee. We failed to keep the one commandment in the garden, and we also failed to keep the ten on the stone. Moses used the first carved stones to destroy the golden calf and those who were worshipping it.

Daniel 2:34

Thou sawest till that a stone was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet that were of iron and clay, and brake them to pieces.

## Battle For The Kingdom Of Men

### Daniel 2:45

Forasmuch as thou sawest that the stone was cut out of the mountain without hands, and that it brake in pieces the iron, the brass, the clay, the silver, and the gold; the great God hath made known to the king what shall come to pass hereafter: and the dream is certain, and the interpretation thereof sure.

### Mark 14:58

We heard him say, I will destroy this temple that is made with hands, and within three days I will build another made without hands.

### Col. 2:11

In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ:

These references refer to things made without hands. Each of these refers to God who made things without hands. Daniel 2:34, 45 clearly show that the law was given to break asunder the mingling of the two races, angelic and men. In the Old Testament, God warns Israel not to intermarry with the heathens. He said do not allow them to dwell among you unless they were circumcised. In the New Testament, He said we ought not to be unequally yoked to the unbeliever. We can also read there in the New Testament that we will know those who love Christ because they will confess who He is. 2 John 1:7 states, "For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist." There is your proof of who you can trust. The fallen angels did not stop mingling after the flood and I do not believe they have ever stopped. Further, by keeping the law we would have been able to destroy all other pretenders to God's throne; those made of iron, brass, clay, silver, and gold. (See other articles posted on this topic) The law could not save us because we failed to keep them. So God had to bring to pass what He knew before the foundations of the world would be the salvation of the kingdom of men – His only begotten Son and the angelic host that will come with Jesus upon His return will be the iron that will break iron – the holy angels will encounter the fallen angels for the final battle of creation and God will be on the side of the kingdom of men. Actually, Jeremiah 15:12 states, "Shall iron break the northern iron and the steel?" Iron is a pure ore and steel is iron mixed with an alloy – angelic mixed with human. This great angelic army that will return with the Messiah will be just what will be needed to break asunder once and for all the fallen angels, iron, and their offspring, steel.

There are signs that we must look for before all of this comes to pass. Jeremiah 15:4 gives us a picture of what is to come and how we can recognize the signs of the imminent return of Jesus to our rescue. "And I will cause them to be removed into all kingdoms of the earth, because of Manasseh the son of Hezekiah king of Judah, for that which he did in Jerusalem." Not only will it be as it was in the days of Noah but also worst than in the days of Manasseh, the most evil of all the kings of Israel.

### 2 Chronicles 33:3-9

[3] For he built again the high places which Hezekiah his father had broken down, and he reared up altars for Baalim, and made groves, and worshipped all the host of heaven, and served them. [4] Also he built altars in the house of the Lord, whereof the Lord had said, In Jerusalem shall my name be for ever. [5] And he built altars for all the host of heaven in the two courts of the house of the Lord. [6] And he caused his children to pass through the fire in the valley of the son of Hinnom: also he observed times, and

used enchantments, and used witchcraft, and dealt with a familiar spirit, and with wizards: he wrought much evil in the sight of the Lord, to provoke him to anger. [7] And he set a carved image, the idol which he had made, in the house of God, of which God had said to David and to Solomon his son, In this house, and in Jerusalem, which I have chosen before all the tribes of Israel, will I put my name for ever: [8] Neither will I any more remove the foot of Israel from out of the land which I have appointed for your fathers; so that they will take heed to do all that I have commanded them, according to the whole law and the statutes and the ordinances by the hand of Moses. [9] So Manasseh made Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem to err, and to do worse than the heathen, whom the Lord had destroyed before the children of Israel.

Look at what Manasseh had brought Israel to. This was the ultimate of defilement to God's temple:

1. built high places
2. reared up altars to Baalim
3. made groves
4. WORSHIPED ALL THE HOST OF HEAVEN and served them
5. built altars in the house of the Lord
6. built altars for all the HOST OF HEAVEN in two courts of the temple
7. sacrificed their children in the fire
8. observed times (astrology)
9. used enchantments
10. used witchcraft
11. dealt with familiar spirits dealt with wizards
12. provoked God to anger
13. set a carved image in the house of God
14. did worse than the heathens

If you have the opportunity to visit Israel today, you will see that we are poised for the coming of the Messiah's return. Israel is a nation that has allowed all the false deities of the world to come in and set up idols. You can meet people who are from all walks of life and are all on diverse spiritual journeys. Two days ago in Tel Aviv I encountered a man who claimed that he is god and that he is here to unite the world. He said that he was also an angel and although he claimed to have found the truth, he could not tell me what it was. It was a great secret that we was not prepared to share. The secular Jew in Israel has come from the four corners of the earth. They have spent centuries scattered to the four corners of the earth and what unites them is their Jewish blood. They are not united by faith. Each has brought back to Israel their own take of God from wherever they have been. The Orthodox Jews are still looking for the Messiah to come the first time and so they really do not care about Israel as a nation. As long as they are able to debate the Torah and the Talmud and pray they are ok. Many Jews are also Kabbalist, this is a blending of Judaism and the Babylonian religions from when Israel was in captivity there for 70 years. Literally, many of the foreigners I meet are here on a spiritual journey. The Muslims have their rock on the temple mount and the Orthodox Jews have their praying wall, the Christian have they historical sights, and the heathens are looking for some unseen energy that will bring them into enlightenment. We are poised for the end of time and don't seem to realize it because we have some false expectation of what we've read in the Left Behind series.

## Battle For The Kingdom Of Men

What is that abomination that causes desolation? It is clearly the worst of what we have seen in Manasseh's time. Daniel 12:11 states, "And from the time that the daily sacrifice shall be taken away, and the abomination that maketh desolate set up, there shall be a thousand two hundred and ninety days." It would appear that man will once again try to offer God an inferior sacrifice, inferior because Jesus Christ is God's final sacrifice requirement. He was rejected and anything apart from Him is an inferior sacrifice. The Jews desire to return to the sacrifices of old, bulls and rams. God utterly rejects anything other than His Son. When this attempt to reconstitute the daily animal sacrifice fails, then an idol will be erected. This idol would appear to be in the likeness of one of the heavenly hosts. This will be angelic worship - those who desire to be as gods. This will be the ultimate insult to God who also created those deceivers. The idol will be referred to as the god of the forces.

## Daniel 11:35-39

[35] And some of them of understanding shall fall, to try them, and to purge, and to make them white, even to the time of the end: because it is yet for a time appointed. [36] And the king shall do according to his will; and he shall exalt himself, and magnify himself above every god, and shall speak marvellous things against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the indignation be accomplished: for that that is determined shall be done. [37] Neither shall he regard the God of his fathers, nor the desire of women, nor regard any god: for he shall magnify himself above all. [38] But in his estate shall he honour the God of forces: and a god whom his fathers knew not shall he honour with gold, and silver, and with precious stones, and pleasant things. [39] Thus shall he do in the most strong holds with a strange god, whom he shall acknowledge and increase with glory: and he shall cause them to rule over many, and shall divide the land for gain.

Are you getting a picture of what we are in for? We are looking for someone who will do worst than Manasseh. Read the book of Daniel and focus in on chapter 11 and see what will befall the kingdom of men, the south, and the kingdom of the fallen, the north. It will surely be as in the days of Noah when the watchers took wives of the daughters of men.

## Matthew 24:37-38

[37] But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. [38] For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark,

## Luke 17:26-27

[26] And as it was in the days of Noe, so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man. [27] They did eat, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, and the flood came, and destroyed them all.

They were marrying and giving in marriage in Noah's day. Angelic beings were taking the daughters of men in marriage and hence the giants were given birth to. Iron and clay cleave to one another, but the time is coming when it will not cleave. Perhaps today they are not cleaving and so the rush and push to experiment with DNA, brainstem research, and alternative forms of procreation. Look at how fast research is moving and the debates about cloning. If you can clone a human being then you do not need man so we can be annihilated. Isn't this the ultimate desire of the enemy?

Daniel 11:17

He shall also set his face to enter with the strength of his whole kingdom, and upright ones with him; thus shall he do: and he shall give him the daughter of women, corrupting her: but she shall not stand on his side, neither be for him.

The kingdom of men will finally reject the exploits of the enemy and refuse to accept his deceptions. Yet one will rise up in the kingdom of men who will be influenced by the enemy to deceive men by flatteries. Look at this man's character:

Daniel 11:24

He shall enter peaceably even upon the fattest places of the province; and he shall do that which his fathers have not done, nor his fathers' fathers; he shall scatter among them the prey, and spoil, and riches: yea, and he shall forecast his devices against the strong holds, even for a time.

Daniel 11:36-37

[36] And the king shall do according to his will; and he shall exalt himself, and magnify himself above every god, and shall speak marvellous things against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the indignation be accomplished: for that that is determined shall be done. [37] Neither shall he regard the God of his fathers, nor the desire of women, nor regard any god: for he shall magnify himself above all.

This is what will transpire with the kingdom of men. If you continue to read the Book of Daniel, you will see that ultimately, Michael will stand up for Israel the people of the covenant because God is on our side.

Daniel 12:1-3

[1] And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book. [2] And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt. [3] And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.

God is on the side of the kingdom of men. He is able to give this kingdom of men to whom ever He likes. Man gave up dominion when we yielded to the lies of the serpent in the garden. We lost dominion. He enemy has supplanted us. But a time is coming when that dominion will be given back to men by the Messiah Himself. (See article on Dominion)

This article is only a foundation for further study. You must know the truth for yourself. It is imperative that you read the Bible and understand it clearly. You can read every doctrinal dissertation on this topic and every hardback or paperback copy of Left behind or some other rendition of what is to come. Your true source and confirmation should come from the Bible. Do not say I will leave such things to the experts. The Holy Spirit is the true expert. He will bring you into all truth. Just pick up the Bible and read it. Get a good Greek and Hebrew dictionary and look up the words for clearer understanding. Spent time meditating on the word of god and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to you the revealed word of God. It is intended for you to understand.

He says study and we say interpret doctrine apart from what we have already received. They come up with such doctrines as prosperity and taking dominion back. We ought to be storing up treasures in heaven and take dominion over sin because only Jesus can give dominion back to the saints. We do not understand the simply things of the word of God because we are consumed by our own agenda. God is still the God of the kingdom of men. We ought to trust fully in Him.

## Chapter 8

### Battle For The Kingdom Of Men

Daniel Chapter 11 speaks about two kings, the king of the north and the king of the south. At this point, Daniel is now in service to Darius the Mede, but the text is not referring to the earthly kingdom of the Medes who conquered the Persian Empire. Daniel 11:2-4 makes mention of three kings in Persia. Again, the kings that are being referred to are angelic kingdoms not earthly kingdoms. Remember that Satan is a counterfeiter and is always counterfeiting everything God does. As there is an anti-Christ, there are also angelic carbon copies of earthly kingdoms as is noted by the angel who is speaking to Daniel in Daniel 10: 13 and Daniel 10:20-21.

Daniel 10:13

But **the prince of the kingdom of Persia** withstood me one and twenty days: but, lo, **Michael, one of the chief princes**, came to help me; and I remained there with the **kings of Persia**. (We know that they was only one king in Persia at the time, Cyrus Daniel 10:1)

Daniel 10:20-21

Then said he, Knowest thou wherefore I come unto thee? and now will I return to fight with the **prince of Persia**: and when I am gone forth, lo, the prince of Grecia shall come. But I will shew thee that which is noted in the scripture of truth: and there is none that holdeth with me in these things, but **Michael your prince**.

So as we see in Daniel 11:2-4, there will be three kings in Persia, the angelic realm at the same time, a fourth that will rise up and be far richer than the other three. He will stir up all the kings of Persia against the king of Grecia. (No honor among thieves). This mention of Grecia is as noted in Daniel 10:20 as there is a prince of Grecia. A might king shall stand up among them and shall rule with great dominion – rule, power. This kingdom will be divided toward the four winds of heaven. This is a scattering in the heavens that will end up on the earth. It seems that they will be a fight to conquer as much as any one can get.

Daniel 11:2-4

[2] And now will I shew thee the truth. Behold, there shall stand up yet three **kings in Persia**; and the fourth shall be far richer than they all: and by his strength through his riches he shall stir up all against the **realm of Grecia**. [3] And a mighty king shall stand up, that shall rule with great dominion, and do according to his will. [4] And when he shall stand up, his kingdom shall be broken, and shall be divided toward the four winds of heaven; and not to his posterity, nor according to his dominion which he ruled: for his kingdom shall be plucked up, even for others beside those.

There is yet hope. Daniel 11 verses 5 and verse 7 identifies the Messiah as the ultimate conqueror. His dominion shall be a great dominion. This relates to the text mention of “one of his princes,” and “out of a branch of her root.” Before that happens, the final defeat, many things will transpire. “And the king of the south shall be strong, and one of his princes; and he shall be strong above him, and have dominion; his dominion shall be a great dominion. But out of a branch of her roots shall one stand up in his estate, which

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shall come with an army, and shall enter into the fortress of the king of the north, and shall deal against them, and shall prevail” Daniel 11:5,7.

Luke 17:26 states, “And as it was in the days of Noe, so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man.” Do you remember what Genesis 6 states about the years before the flood and why God brought the flood?

Genesis 6:1-7

[1]And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them, [2] That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose. [3] And the Lord said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years. [4] There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown.

[5] And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. [6] And it repented the Lord that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart. [7] And the Lord said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them.

Genesis 6:11-13

[11] The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence. [12] And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth. [13] And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.

Luke 17:27

They did eat, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, and the flood came, and destroyed them all.

We can expect a repeat of Noah’s days: the tainting of the blood line of man with angelic seed, the violence, wickedness and every imagination of thought. How far fetch can this be, Daniel 12:4 states, “But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.” What man conceives He will be able to do with the influence and knowledge of the fallen. Take a look at the alliance that will be formed here, “And in the end of years **they shall join themselves together; for the king's daughter of the south shall come to the king of the north to make an agreement:** but she shall not retain the power of the arm; neither shall he stand, nor his arm: but she shall be given up, and they that brought her, and he that begat her, and he that strengthened her in these times” Daniel 11:6. As in the days of Noah they will also be mingling of angelic seed with the seed of man.

The following verses give us the introduction to the king of the south and the king of the north. The king of the south is the earthly realm (man) and the king of the north is the angelic realm (It is speaking of the fallen angelic realm).

Daniel 11:5-7

[5] And the **king of the south** shall be strong, and one of his princes; and he shall be strong above him, and have dominion; his dominion shall be a great dominion. [6] And in the end of years they shall join themselves together; for the king's daughter of

the south shall come to the **king of the north** to make an agreement: but she shall not retain the power of the arm; neither shall he stand, nor his arm: but she shall be given up, and they that brought her, and he that begat her, and he that strengthened her in these times. [7] But out of a branch of her roots shall one stand up in his estate, which shall come with an army, and shall enter into the fortress of the king of the north, and shall deal against them, and shall prevail.

Daniel 11:40 gives us a description that points us to the king of the north being angelic. "And at the time of the end shall the king of the south push at him: and the king of the north shall come against him like a whirlwind, with chariots, and with horsemen, and with many ships; and he shall enter into the countries, and shall overflow and pass over." To see the connection we must take a look at Ezekiel 1:4-5 "And I looked, and, behold, a whirlwind came out of the north, a great cloud, and a fire infolding itself, and a brightness was about it, and out of the midst thereof as the colour of amber, out of the midst of the fire. Also out of the midst thereof came the likeness of four living creatures. And this was their appearance; they had the likeness of a man." This was an angel being that appeared to Ezekiel while he was by the river Chebar. The mention of whirlwind denotes something supernatural occurring or something propelled supernaturally.

2 Kings 2:1

And it came to pass, when the Lord would take up Elijah into heaven by a whirlwind, that Elijah went with Elisha from Gilgal.

2 Kings 2:11

And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, there appeared a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.

Job 38:1

Then the Lord answered Job out of the whirlwind, and said,

Job 40:6

Then answered the Lord unto Job out of the whirlwind, and said,

Isaiah 5:28

Whose arrows are sharp, and all their bows bent, their horses' hoofs shall be counted like flint, and their wheels like a whirlwind:

Isaiah 40:24

Yea, they shall not be planted; yea, they shall not be sown: yea, their stock shall not take root in the earth: and he shall also blow upon them, and they shall wither, and the whirlwind shall take them away as stubble.

Isaiah 41:16

Thou shalt fan them, and the wind shall carry them away, and the whirlwind shall scatter them: and thou shalt rejoice in the Lord, and shalt glory in the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 66:15

For, behold, the Lord will come with fire, and with his chariots like a whirlwind, to render his anger with fury, and his rebuke with flames of fire.

Jeremiah 4:13

Behold, he shall come up as clouds, and his chariots shall be as a whirlwind: his horses are swifter than eagles. Woe unto us! for we are spoiled.

Jeremiah 23:19

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Behold, a whirlwind of the Lord is gone forth in fury, even a grievous whirlwind: it shall fall grievously upon the head of the wicked.

Jeremiah 25:32

Thus saith the Lord of hosts, Behold, evil shall go forth from nation to nation, and a great whirlwind shall be raised up from the coasts of the earth.

Jeremiah 30:23

Behold, the whirlwind of the Lord goeth forth with fury, a continuing whirlwind: it shall fall with pain upon the head of the wicked.

Ezekiel 1:4

And I looked, and, behold, a whirlwind came out of the north, a great cloud, and a fire infolding itself, and a brightness was about it, and out of the midst thereof as the colour of amber, out of the midst of the fire.

Daniel 11:40

And at the time of the end shall the king of the south push at him: and the king of the north shall come against him like a whirlwind, with chariots, and with horsemen, and with many ships; and he shall enter into the countries, and shall overflow and pass over.

Hosea 8:7

For they have sown the wind, and they shall reap the whirlwind: it hath no stalk: the bud shall yield no meal: if so be it yield, the strangers shall swallow it up.

Nahum 1:3

The Lord is slow to anger, and great in power, and will not at all acquit the wicked: the Lord hath his way in the whirlwind and in the storm, and the clouds are the dust of his feet.

Zech. 7:14

But I scattered them with a whirlwind among all the nations whom they knew not. Thus the land was desolate after them, that no man passed through nor returned: for they laid the pleasant land desolate.

The king of the south is the realm of man as we see the Messiah having dominion and the branch of her roots being the Son of Man who shall prevail on the side of humanity. The only place that the king of the south and the king of the north are mentioned is in the book of Daniel.

### **North: wn, Hebrew 6828, Strong's**

**tsaphown**, *tsaw-fone'*; or **tsaphon**, *tsaw-fone'*; from Hebrew 6845 (*tsaphan*); properly *hidden*, i.e. *dark*; used only of the *north* as a quarter (*gloomy* and *unknown*) :- north (-ern, side, -ward, wind). (As in the fallen angelic host)

### **South: negeb, Hebrew 5045, Strong's**

**negeb**, *neh'-gheb*; from an unused root meaning to *be parched*; the *south* (from its drought); specifically the *Negeb* or southern district of Judah, occasionally, *Egypt* (as south to Palestine) :- south (country, side, -ward). (As in the realm of man, specifically, Israel as we see the Messiah coming from that people of the covenant)

Daniel 11:8-9 denotes the captivity of Israel and the return to the land. This is a kingdom that shall out last that of the king of the north. The nation shall be stirred up and shall gather their forces together and fight with the king of the north and they will be given into the hands of the king of the south (man). Pride over the victory will move the

king to act swiftly and destroy tens of thousands, angels, but it will not make the kingdom of man stronger.

The king of the north will gather his forces and return after several years with a great army and much riches. This force will come against the king of the south. There will be many false prophets about then. The great cities will be taken by the king of the north and the arms of the south shall not withstand. The king of the north will invade and consume the glorious land, Israel. One will rise out of that kingdom to usurp others by coming peaceably, and obtain the kingdom by flatteries...The kingdom of the south will rise up but will be defeated again. The king of the north and the king of the south will have mischief in their hearts one to another. Read the text in its entirety and understand the goings on between these two kingdoms; the north being the angelic and the south being man.

#### Daniel 11:1-45

[1] Also I in the first year of Darius the Mede, even I, stood to confirm and to strengthen him. [2] And now will I shew thee the truth. Behold, there shall stand up yet three kings in Persia; and the fourth shall be far richer than they all: and by his strength through his riches he shall stir up all against the realm of Grecia. [3] And a mighty king shall stand up, that shall rule with great dominion, and do according to his will. [4] And when he shall stand up, his kingdom shall be broken, and shall be divided toward the four winds of heaven; and not to his posterity, nor according to his dominion which he ruled: for his kingdom shall be plucked up, even for others beside those.

[5] And the **king of the south** shall be strong, and one of his princes; and he shall be strong above him, and have dominion; his dominion shall be a great dominion. [6] **And in the end of years they shall join themselves together; for the king's daughter of the south shall come to the king of the north to make an agreement:** but she shall not retain the power of the arm; neither shall he stand, nor his arm: but she shall be given up, and they that brought her, and he that begat her, and he that strengthened her in these times. [7] But out of a branch of her roots shall one stand up in his estate, which shall come with an army, and shall enter into the fortress of the **king of the north**, and shall deal against them, and shall prevail: [8] And shall also carry captives into Egypt their gods, with their princes, and with their precious vessels of silver and of gold; and he shall continue more years than the **king of the north**. [9] So the **king of the south** shall come into his kingdom, and shall return into his own land. [10] But his sons shall be stirred up, and shall assemble a multitude of great forces: and one shall certainly come, and overflow, and pass through: then shall he return, and be stirred up, even to his fortress. [11] And the **king of the south** shall be moved with choler, and shall come forth and fight with him, even with the **king of the north**: and he shall set forth a great multitude; but the multitude shall be given into his hand. [12] And when he hath taken away the multitude, his heart shall be lifted up; and he shall cast down many ten thousands: but he shall not be strengthened by it. [13] For the **king of the north** shall return, and shall set forth a multitude greater than the former, and shall certainly come after certain years with a great army and with much riches. [14] And in those times there shall many stand up against the **king of the south**: also the robbers of thy people shall exalt themselves to establish the vision; but they shall fall. [15] So the **king of the north** shall come, and cast up a mount, and take the most fenced cities: and the arms of the south shall not withstand, neither his chosen people, neither shall there be any strength to withstand. [16] But he that cometh against him shall do according to his own will, and none shall stand before him: and he shall stand in the glorious land, which by his hand shall be consumed. [17] He shall also set his face to

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enter with the strength of his whole kingdom, and upright ones with him; thus shall he do: and he shall give him the daughter of women, corrupting her: but she shall not stand on his side, neither be for him. [18] After this shall he turn his face unto the isles, and shall take many: but a prince for his own behalf shall cause the reproach offered by him to cease; without his own reproach he shall cause it to turn upon him. [19] Then he shall turn his face toward the fort of his own land: but he shall stumble and fall, and not be found. [20] Then shall stand up in his estate a raiser of taxes in the glory of the kingdom: but within few days he shall be destroyed, neither in anger, nor in battle. [21] And in his estate shall stand up a vile person, to whom they shall not give the honour of the kingdom: but he shall come in peaceably, and obtain the kingdom by flatteries. [22] And with the arms of a flood shall they be overflowed from before him, and shall be broken; yea, also the prince of the covenant. [23] And after the league made with him he shall work deceitfully: for he shall come up, and shall become strong with a small people. [24] He shall enter peaceably even upon the fattest places of the province; and he shall do that which his fathers have not done, nor his fathers' fathers; he shall scatter among them the prey, and spoil, and riches: yea, and he shall forecast his devices against the strong holds, even for a time. [25] And he shall stir up his power and his courage against the **king of the south** with a great army; and the **king of the south** shall be stirred up to battle with a very great and mighty army; but he shall not stand: for they shall forecast devices against him. [26] Yea, they that feed of the portion of his meat shall destroy him, and his army shall overflow: and many shall fall down slain. [27] And both these kings' hearts shall be to do mischief, and they shall speak lies at one table; but it shall not prosper: for yet the end shall be at the time appointed. [28] Then shall he return into his land with great riches; and his heart shall be against the holy covenant; and he shall do exploits, and return to his own land. [29] At the time appointed he shall return, and come toward the south; but it shall not be as the former, or as the latter.

[30] For the ships of Chittim shall come against him: therefore he shall be grieved, and return, and have indignation against the holy covenant: so shall he do; he shall even return, and have intelligence with them that forsake the holy covenant. [31] And arms shall stand on his part, and they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength, and shall take away the daily sacrifice, and they shall place the abomination that maketh desolate. [32] And such as do wickedly against the covenant shall he corrupt by flatteries: but the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits. [33] And they that understand among the people shall instruct many: yet they shall fall by the sword, and by flame, by captivity, and by spoil, many days. [34] Now when they shall fall, they shall be holpen with a little help: but many shall cleave to them with flatteries. [35] And some of them of understanding shall fall, to try them, and to purge, and to make them white, even to the time of the end: because it is yet for a time appointed. [36] And the king shall do according to his will; and he shall exalt himself, and magnify himself above every god, and shall speak marvellous things against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the indignation be accomplished: for that that is determined shall be done. [37] Neither shall he regard the God of his fathers, nor the desire of women, nor regard any god: for he shall magnify himself above all. [38] But in his estate shall he honour the God of forces: and a god whom his fathers knew not shall he honour with gold, and silver, and with precious stones, and pleasant things. [39] Thus shall he do in the most strong holds with a strange god, whom he shall acknowledge and increase with glory: and he shall cause them to rule over many, and shall divide the land for gain. [40] And at the time of the end shall the **king of the south** push at him: and the **king of the north** shall come against him like a whirlwind, with chariots, and with horsemen,

(see Ezekiel 1:4) and with many ships; and he shall enter into the countries, and shall overflow and pass over. [41] He shall enter also into the glorious land, and many countries shall be overthrown: but these shall escape out of his hand, even Edom, and Moab, and the chief of the children of Ammon. [42] He shall stretch forth his hand also upon the countries: and the land of Egypt shall not escape. [43] But he shall have power over the treasures of gold and of silver, and over all the precious things of Egypt: and the Libyans and the Ethiopians shall be at his steps. [44] But tidings out of the east and out of the north shall trouble him: therefore he shall go forth with great fury to destroy, and utterly to make away many. [45] And he shall plant the tabernacles of his palace between the seas in the glorious holy mountain; yet he shall come to his end, and none shall help him.

The two kingdoms shall do battle against each other. The books of Isaiah and Joel tell us more about this battle for the kingdom of men.

## Chapter 9

### Final Dominion

The first occurrence on dominion is found in genesis 1:26-28 which states, “[26] And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. [27] So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. [28] And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.” Man having been created at this point was given dominion over the fishes, birds, and living things on the earth.

#### **Dominion - radah, Hebrew 7287, Strong’s**

**radah**, *raw-daw'*; a primitive root; to *tread* down, i.e. *subjugate*; specifically to *crumble* off :- (come to, make to) have dominion, prevail against, reign, (bear, make to) rule, (-r, over), take.

Imagine the implication of this word in relation to man and the beast of the earth. Man was given authority from God to subjugate, reign and rule over all fish, birds, and living things on the earth. That is a tremendous amount of power and authority. Not only did God give man such authority, but He also endowed the animals to be receptive to man’s reign and rule over them. When man lost dominion because of sin, the principalities took dominion and we see the horrible extent of that dominion and we are still experiencing it today.

#### Genesis 6:1-12

[1] And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them, [2] That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose. [3] And the Lord said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years. [4] There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown.

[5] And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. [6] And it repented the Lord that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart. [7] And the Lord said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them. [8] But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord.

[9] These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God. [10] And Noah begat three sons, Shem, Ham, and Japheth. [11] The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence. [12] **And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth.**

Prior to this corruption of all life on the earth, the animals adhere to Adam.

“[19] And out of the ground the Lord God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof. [20] And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for Adam there was not found an help meet for him” Genesis 2:19-20. This indicates that they was a sense of the creatures being presented to the one who had rule over them, namely Adam. It can be concluded from this text that they arrived, were presented, and was obedient not just to God but to Adam as well. All of this radically changed when sin entered into the picture.

World history went from “it was good,” to all flesh had corrupted his way, to all flesh being destroyed with the exception of Noah and his family and the creatures that God had him place on the ark. This all occurred in a matter of eight generations from creation, Adam. Man was given dominion (Genesis 1:28), man lost dominion (Genesis 1:6), and then utter corruption of creation (Genesis 6:1-12) by the sons of God. Man was appointed to care for the living creatures of the earth and tend the garden. By the act of disobedience to God’s simple command, not to eat of the tree of knowledge of good and evil, all that changed. By deception, the principalities took dominion from man. Man was no longer able to care for himself further more look out for the well-being of the animals. Man’s concern turned to working by the sweat of his brows to survive the harshness of life outside of the garden. Every man and creature had to fend for themselves.

After the flood we see a clearer picture of the position of man to animal and animal to man. Genesis 9:1-3 states, “[1] And God blessed Noah and his sons, and said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth. [2] And the fear of you and the dread of you shall be upon every beast of the earth, and upon every fowl of the air, upon all that moveth upon the earth, and upon all the fishes of the sea; into your hand are they delivered. [3] Every moving thing that liveth shall be meat for you; even as the green herb have I given you all things.” In these verses, God leaves out “subdue”, and “have dominion over.” Let’s look at this comparatively:

**Genesis 1:26-28**

Be fruitful

**Genesis 9:1-2**

Be fruitful  
 Multiply  
 Replenish  
 Fear of you and the dread of you  
 Delivered into hands (for meat)

In Genesis 1:28 man was given dominion. Psalm 8:4-9 attest to this. “[4] What is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him? [5] For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour. [6] Thou madest him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all things under his feet: [7] All sheep and oxen, yea, and the beasts of the field; [8] The fowl of the air, and the fish of the sea, and whatsoever passeth through the paths of the seas. [9] O Lord our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth!” “Thou madest him” was God’s original intent – for man to have dominion.

In Genesis 9 dominion was clearly removed. In Genesis 1 man reigned and ruled over the living things and in Genesis 9 the creatures’ fears man and man fears the creatures. The creature will now become the hunted as food for man, and likewise man becomes prey as food for the creatures. Up until this time the green herb was given as

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food for both man and beast. Now we have man and creature becoming territorial. Reign and rule has departed and fear and prey has become the norm.

If you doubt for a moment that dominion still remains in the hands of man, read what Jesus states in Matthew 20:25: "But Jesus called them unto him, and said, Ye know that the princes of the Gentiles exercise dominion over them, and they that are great exercise authority upon them." What Jesus is emphatically stating here is that those that are not of Him have a different ruler who has dominion over them. He is referring to the prince (**archon**, *ar'-khone*; a *first* (in rank or power) :- chief (ruler), magistrate, prince, ruler.) of this world, Satan and his co-horts.

Although man lost dominion of the earth, utter dominion never left the hand of God. It was only man's dominion that was lost not God's; God still and forever rule and reign.

Daniel 4:3

How great are his signs! and how mighty are his wonders! his kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and his dominion is from generation to generation.

Daniel 4:34

And at the end of the days I Nebuchadnezzar lifted up mine eyes unto heaven, and mine understanding returned unto me, and I blessed the most High, and I praised and honoured him that liveth for ever, whose dominion is an everlasting dominion, and his kingdom is from generation to generation:

Daniel 7:14

And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.

Daniel 7:27

And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him.

1 Peter 4:11

If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

1 Peter 5:11

To him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

Jude 1:8

Likewise also these filthy dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities.

Jude 1:25

To the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.

Rev. 1:6

And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

Dominion was, is, and always will be God's for ever and ever. Yet God has chosen at various times to grant to man and principalities dominion. He did so to man, to kings and rulers at various times in history, and to principalities. God has never been afraid to dispense authority. He has only required that we operate within the bounds of His righteousness and commandments. Isn't that funny, He only requires obedience, no less than what He required from His only begotten Son. And Jesus was obedient even unto the death of the cross. Our obedience did not require death, only not eating from one tree. Look at the extent to what God has given and will give dominion.

### **Dominion to man (humanity)**

Genesis 1:28

And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.

### **Dominion specifically to Joseph**

Genesis 37:8

And his brethren said to him, Shalt thou indeed reign over us? or shalt thou indeed have dominion over us? And they hated him yet the more for his dreams, and for his words.

### **Dominion specifically to Jesus**

Numbers 24:19

Out of Jacob shall come he that shall have dominion, and shall destroy him that remaineth of the city.

### **One nation's dominion over Israel because of Israel's apostasy**

Judges 14:4

But his father and his mother knew not that it was of the Lord, that he sought an occasion against the Philistines: for at that time the Philistines had dominion over Israel.

### **Dominion given to principalities**

Daniel 7:6

After this I beheld, and lo another, like a leopard, which had upon the back of it four wings of a fowl; the beast had also four heads; and dominion was given to it.

Daniel 11:5

And the king of the south shall be strong, and one of his princes; and he shall be strong above him, and have dominion; his dominion shall be a great dominion.

In as much as God has given dominion to others for various purposes, and in as much as man has by disobedience given over dominion to principalities, this will not last forever. The dominion of principalities will one day end as we see in Daniel 7:12 "As concerning the rest of the beasts, they had their dominion taken away: yet their lives were prolonged for a season and time." Also in Daniel 7:26 "But the judgment shall sit, and they shall take away his dominion, to consume and to destroy it unto the end." And we see here also in Daniel that dominion shall be given back to the saints. "And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven,

shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him" Daniel 7:27.

The issue of dominion is of great concern to the body of Christ because they are those that are stating that man still has dominion over the earth and they are promoting that man, rather the saints, should actively take back dominion. But Jesus gave us a new commandment in Matthew 28:18-20, "[18] And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. [19] Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: [20] Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen." The action of the church is now predicated on this commandment. The way that the saints shall have dominion is to take it back from the enemy in this manner. We are to take his captives right from under him by preaching the gospel to the lost.

The power to do this is what God has given to us through His son, dominion and power over sin. God has given to us dominion over sin, that which caused us to fall in the first place. This is a greater dominion than dominion over the earth and creatures of the earth. Jesus has given us this greater dominion that the enemy had no idea about because had he known they never would have crucified Christ (see I Corinthians 2:7-8). Jesus has given to us power over sin and that means power over the works of the enemy and all his dominion. In actuality we have power to take from him that which he seeks to dominate, human souls. Satan takes this seriously and we take it lightly. Look at what Romans 6:1-14 states:

[1] What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? [2] God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein? [3] Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? [4] Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. [5] For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection: [6] Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin. [7] For he that is dead is freed from sin. [8] Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him: [9] Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him. [10] For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God. [11] Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord. [12] Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof. [13] Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God. [14] For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.

The thing that caused us to fall from grace God has given us dominion over it, sin. Rejoice for we are no longer masters to sin, but sin must give way to the blood of Jesus. This is the weapon of the tearing down of strongholds. Neither will material possession nor political power give us back dominion over the earth. What will is taking the very souls that Satan have captive away from him. This is now the agenda of the church. Restoration of any earthly dominion is left in the hands of Jesus. He and only He shall restore it to the saints.

Daniel 7:13-14

[13] I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. [14] And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.

Daniel 7:27

And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him.

The sum of all this is that God has total dominion, He has given dominion into His Son's hands, man had dominion, man lost dominion, the beast will be given dominion for a season in the latter days, dominion will be taken away from the beast and given completely to Jesus who will give dominion back to the saints. In this order and any thing short of this is not according to God's word. Let us be careful to do what God has commanded us to do. Do not let the enemy sidetrack us any longer. We have dominion over sin so let us use it to tear down the devil's stronghold on the souls of others.

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
